### INTRODUCTION

Passenger lists help pinpoint when an immigrant ancestor first arrived in this country. These records may provide you with the following information:

- Immigrant's nationality and place of birth
- Ship name and date of entry to the United States
- Age, height, eye, and hair color
- Profession
- Place of last residence
- Name and address of relatives they are joining in the U.S.
- Amount of money they are carrying, etc.

Our collection offers lists from various European nations and tends to focus on Atlantic Ocean port cities. The Grosvenor Room (GRO) and the Western New York Genealogical Society (WNYGS) collect passenger lists that have been indexed or published in print or book form. Neither organization offers passenger lists on microfilm.

In addition to the general and specific guides included in this bibliography, the Library owns many passenger lists focused on specific nations and ethnicities, not all of which are listed here. This list shows the most popular and frequently used titles. The Library's collection is not comprehensive, meaning that it does not include the names of every person who ever came to the United States. Your research may take you to the National Archives or the Family History Centers of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints (LDS).

**Before proceeding with these resources, you will have the best results if you know the name and approximate spelling of the ancestor being sought, as well as the place and approximate dates of departure and arrival.**
