Birth Announcements in Newspapers

Scan the *Buffalo (Evening) News* and the *Courier-Express* for a few weeks after the date of birth, and the *Buffalo Daily Law Journal*. No known index of local newspaper birth notices.

The Vital Records Office in Buffalo City Hall stopped releasing baby names to newspapers in 2006.

Adoptions: Unfortunately, birth notices are a poor source for adoption researchers, as the names of babies intended for adoption were not released to newspapers.

Marriage Announcements in Newspapers

There is no comprehensive index of local newspaper wedding announcements. Browse the *Buffalo (Evening) News*, *Courier-Express*, and the *Buffalo Daily Law Journal* for a few weeks around the date of the wedding. In some years, announcements were published every day, scattered throughout the paper. A brief notice of marriage license may be found in some years.
