Data well for 1.23 should be long enough to accommodate urls. This year we had to put the direct urls for many of the locations in the state note (with our more general library locations page in the data well.) All urls fit, however, in 9.10. So 1.23 should have as much space for data entry as 9.10. Once a state

report question has been assigned a number, this number should not change. If a question is dropped, then it should just be dropped without renumbering the

surrounding questions. If a question needs to be added,

there are numbering schemes out there that would allow this. For example, to insert a question between 3.3 and 3.4, you can put in 3.3a, 3.3.1, etc. Our library system is trying to automate the collection of various numbers, and continually renumbering causes challenges, I'm sure for the state as well as for the libraries. I also recommend an adult and intergenerational "Other" age group for summer reading. That way adult summer reading programs and all of our programs geared toward families in the summer can be counted in the correct spots in the overall totals and in the subsets.
