2016 Statistics

- ◊ 2016 Circulation—225,569 items
- ◊ Total number of questions answered in 2016: 13,987
- Number of uses of public Internet computers—14,088
- ◊ Number of people who visited the Clarence Library−114,365
- Number of registered resident borrowers at the Clarence Library— 12,488
- ◊ Grand Total of items held by the Clarence Library—83,366
- An average of 384 people visited the Clarence Library each day in 2016
- An average of 757 items circulated per day
- ◊ The busiest day of the year was 7/5/2016 when a total of 1,422 items circulated!
- ◊ Programs /Events in 2016:

2016 Highlights

- The Clarence Public Library consistently ranked 8th of 37 libraries for circulation and patron visits in 2016.
- Library WiFi use was up by 112% in 2016!
- Senator Michael Ranzenhofer obtained funding for the Clarence Public Library in the amount of \$10,000 for the purpose of children's programming, updating technology and improving the library.
