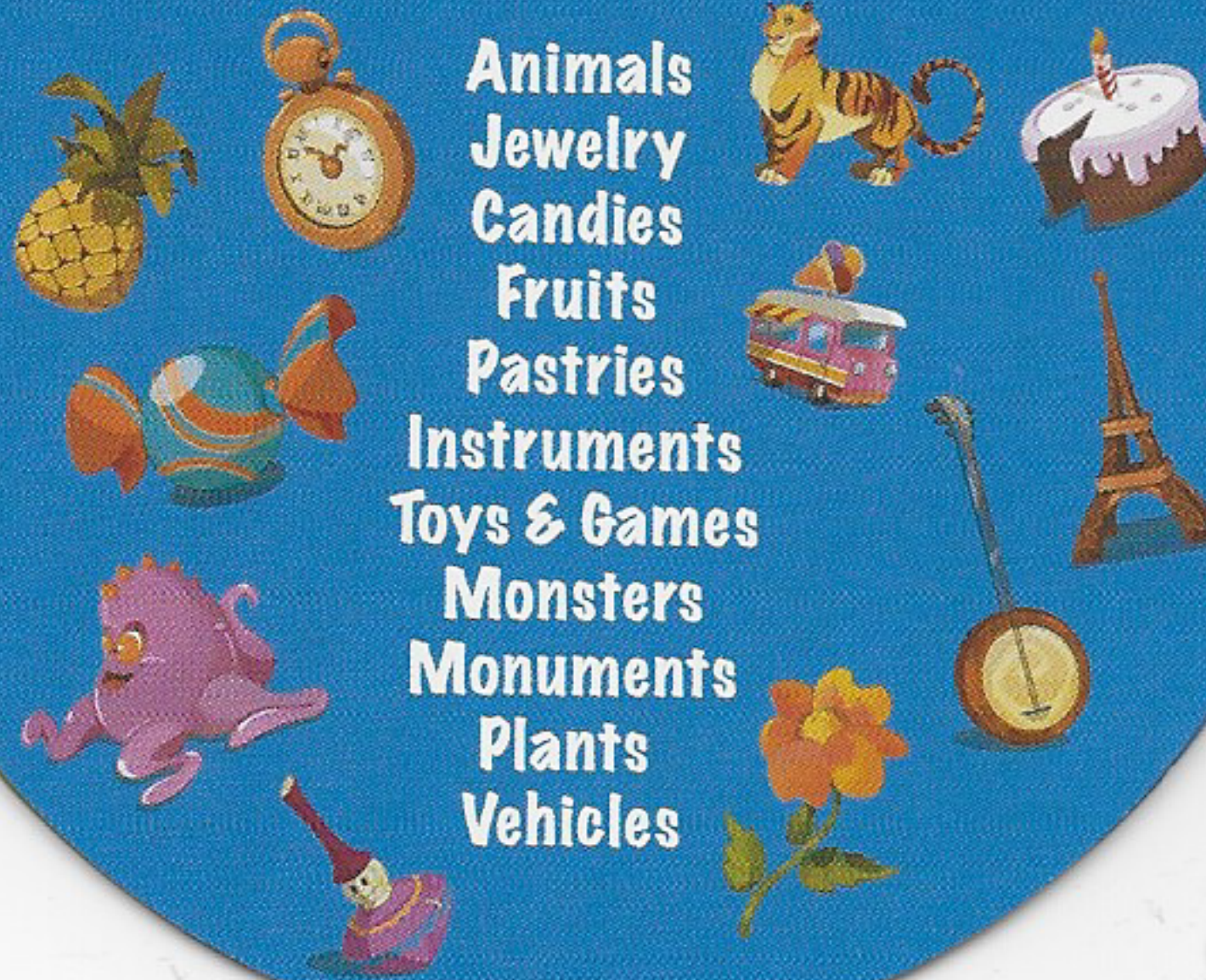
2 - 6 players
Ages 6 and up
10 minutes

Object of the game:
Be the first to quickly identify
cards in the same category
and win the most points!



Components

110 cards, divided into
11 categories, with 10 cards in
each of the following categories:





Set up

All of the cards are shuffled, dealt evenly between the players and placed in facedown piles in front of them.

Any remaining cards are placed back into the box and will not be used this round.

Playing the game

1. Reveal cards

All players simultaneously reveal the top card of their pile, in a manner such that the other players can see the image on their card before they can see it themselves.

All of the revealed cards are placed in the middle of the table with the images clearly visible.



2. Search

At the same time, players race to identify 2 (or more) cards that belong to the same category. When one player identifies a match, he announces the name of the matching category in a loud and clear voice.



If he is **correct**, he scores all of the cards in that category.

If he is **wrong**, he sits quietly until the next turn, when a new round of cards is revealed.



IMPORTANT:

You must always announce your match before grabbing the cards: if another player announces the correct category before you, then he is the one who scores the cards.

If two or more players call out the same category at the same time, then the cards are divided equally between them. Any remaining cards are discarded, and not scored.



3. Reveal a new round of cards

When all players agree there are no remaining matches (or have already claimed their match for the turn), then begin a new turn, adding a new round of cards next to any cards remaining from the previous round. Make sure that all cards are clearly visible because cards from previous rounds may be matched with new cards from this round.

End of the game

The game is over once all of the cards
have been played.

The player who scored the most
cards wins the game.

In the case of a tie,
the victory is shared.
