
3 PLAYERS



SETUP


Place the board between the 2 players. Each player chooses a color *(either red or yellow)*.

Flip all the center 'tiles' to the blue color. Choose a player to go first.




PLAY

On your turn you may either slide one bar one space to the left or right



OR flip one 'tile' to your color. However, you are NOT allowed to flip a 'tile ' that your opponent just flipped.



IMPORTANT! When one player slides a row, the next player CANNOT immediately move it back and must wait until their next turn to slide that bar.

Each bar must remain connected to the board and cannot slide past a total of 3 spaces to the left or right.

WINNING

The first player to get four of their color in a row WINS!
