

28 Double Dominoes (6 Colors) Instructions

How to Play:

- 1) Place all the Dominoes in the center of the playing area face down.
- 2) Each player picks 5 dominoes. The remaining dominoes left on the table are called the "pile". Move the "pile" to one side to clear the center for game play.
- 3) Youngest player goes first, and then play continues to the player's right.
- 4) First player lays a domino down in the center. The next player must place a domino with a matching image, if the player has one, in line, end to end with the domino already placed down. Doubles should be laid at a right angel to all other dominoes, allowing dominoes to be connected in all four directions.
- 5) If a player cannot make a move because he/she does not have a domino that matches, the player must draw from the "pile" until he/she finds one that does. If no matching domino can be found, and all of the dominoes from the 'pile' are gone, the player loses a turn.
- 6) The winner is the first player to lay down all his/her dominoes.
