Preliminary budget financials

for the month ending 12/31/2002

BACKGROUND:

The attached reports provide a summary of revenues and expenditures in the Library's Operating and Erie County Capital for Library Budgets for the year as of December 31, 2002. Overall, the Library operated within its budget and expectations for the period. These results are final, subject to completion of the County's outside audit. At this point no material audit changes are anticipated. Should any changes occur, they will be reported to the board.

Items of note include:

- ✓ A separate "2001 Encumbrances" column shows the amount of 2001 encumbrances (the remaining value of outstanding purchase orders and contracts at the 2001 year-end), which are available to cover 2002 expenditures for these contractually obligated items.
- ✓ Sufficient funds are available to support the \$550,000 2003 use of fund balance commitment as well as \$563,785 previously re-appropriated by Board Resolution into the 2003 Budget for ongoing projects/commitments.
