



National Library Week April 14 - 20, 2013

Plenty to do at all 37 Buffalo & Erie County Public Libraries

Library tours, book clubs for all ages, book sales, author visits, story times, computer training, Lego club, science for kids, movies, Japanese rock garden building, genealogy research, open houses, special displays, and crafts are just a few of the free programs featured next week in the 37 Buffalo & Erie County Public Libraries during *National Library Week*, (April 14-20). One of the highlights of the week takes place at the Frank E. Merriweather Library (1324 Jefferson Avenue in Buffalo) on Tuesday, April 16 when community leaders read from Martin Luther King, Jr.'s "Letter from Birmingham Jail," written 50 years ago.

"We invite the community to celebrate all of the great things libraries have to offer – during National Library Week and throughout the year," said Mary Jean Jakubowski, Library System director. "Libraries are a great return on your investment. For every \$1 received from Erie County, the Buffalo & Erie County Public Libraries provide \$6.56 back to the community in services like computer training, database research, interlibrary loans, family programs, book, music and video downloads, and of course, book and materials lending. Libraries are changing – they're full of activity and excitement – the look and feel is that of community. I hope folks will discover or rediscover what libraries have to offer during National Library Week. Come see us, it will be worth the trip!"

First commemorated in 1958, National Library Week is a national observance sponsored by the American Library Association (ALA) and celebrated by libraries across the country each April. A poll conducted in 2012 by the ALA found

that 94% of respondents agreed that public libraries play an important role in giving everyone a chance to succeed because they provide free access to materials and resources. The Buffalo & Erie County Public Library System has more than 2.6 million materials available for borrowing including books, eBooks, DVDs, music and more.
