Bullying Stops Here Month @ Buffalo & Erie County Public Libraries

Libraries receive national recognition for month-long community awareness campaign

The 3rd annual" Bullying Stops Here" communitywide initiative kicked off at the downtown Central Library today with Erie County Executive Mark C. Poloncarz, Congressman Brian Higgins, and Buffalo Public Schools Associate Superintendent Will Keresztes. Other attendees included Erie County Legislator Peter J. Savage; Kimberly Trent, representing the City of Buffalo's Commission on Citizens' Rights and Community Relations; a dozen local human service agency partners; students from Bennett Park Montessori School, singer Kevin McCarthy, young entrepreneur Daniel Gibbs; and the Library System's new owl mascot "Reada Book."

"This is a special year for our anti-bullying campaign," said Library System Director Mary Jean Jakubowski. "A few weeks ago, our "Bullying Stops Here" program was featured in the September issue of the national magazine American Libraries! I am proud to report the Buffalo & Erie County Public Library System is recognized as a leading example of libraries that are helping kids stand up to bullying."

"Bullying is hurtful and has negative consequences that can last a lifetime," said Erie County Executive Mark C. Poloncarz. "We need to stand up as a community to stop bullying by treating others with kindness and compassion and by stepping in when we see someone else being bullied."
