Several free classes on improving your personal finances will be offered at the downtown Central Library, 1 Lafayette Square, during "Money Smart Week," held nationally April 18-25.

"Money Smart Week," now in its fifth year, is a national collaboration of the Federal Reserve Bank, Chicago, and the American Library Association as a means to bring attention to and encourage financial literacy.

Free "Money Smart Week" classes at the Downtown Library include:

Monday, April 20, 10 a.m.-12 noon - *Finding Consumer Information on the Internet.* Learn where to compare products, get reliable information on automobiles, contractors, insurance companies, physicians, and hospitals, and find the cheapest gasoline prices.

Monday, April 20, 12 noon-1 p.m. - *First-Time Home Buying*

Presented by Belmont Housing: What do you need to know before you buy your first home? Learn about the programs available to first-time Home Buyers.

Wednesday, April 22, 10 a.m.-12 noon - *Creating a Household Budget*

Discover how to draw up a budget using Microsoft Excel and successfully manage your money to avoid financial surprises.

Thursday, April 23, 12 noon-1 p.m. - *Identity Theft*

Presented by the Buffalo Urban League: Learn how to protect yourself from the risks of identity theft. What can you do if you are an identity theft victim?

Saturday, April 25, 10 a.m.-12 noon-*Introduction to the Library's Career & Job Search Databases*
