Buffalo will host its third annual **Indie Author Day on Saturday, October 13 from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. More than 55 local authors will showcase their publications, representing a cross-section of all types of literature.**

Part of a worldwide effort to connect independent authors with public libraries, *Indie Author Day* will offer local writers a rare opportunity to network with other authors, share their work with the public and learn the ins and outs of self-publishing and marketing their books. The event will include presentations by local publishing experts as well as streaming videos featuring leaders in the self-publishing industry. Attendees can mingle with the local writers and purchase copies of their books at this event, which is **free and open to the public.**
