Nov 18, 2019 - Jan 11, 2020 Dudley - Closed - Construction. Re-opened 1/13/2020.

Feb 27, 2020 Alden, Aurora, Collins, Hamburg, Lackawanna, Lake Shore, Marilla - Closed - Weather.

Beginning Mar 17, 2020 System-wide - All libraries temporarily closed beginning 3/17/2020 and remain closed consistent with the Governor’s Stay at Home Order to slow the spread of Coronavirus (COVID-19). They shall remain closed until such time as the guidance of the Governor of the State of New York supports reopening. The Amherst, Clarence, and Lackawanna libraries also closed on 3/16/2020.
