SYSTEM-WIDE: Several libraries reduced operating hours in 2006 due to budget cutbacks. These reductions are in

addition to service hour reductions that occurred in January 2005. Fewer service hours affected

circulation at many libraries.

Central: BS&T, Grosvenor & Children's are closed on Fridays (begun in Nov. 2005) for a reduction of 24 hrs. per

week. In addition, BS&T has a later opening (also begun in Nov. 2005), 10 AM rather than 8:30, (Grosvenor & Children's instituted those opening hours in January 2005), for an additional reduction of

9 hrs. per week in BS&T.

Closed 10/13 through 10/15/2006 due to snowstorm, power outages and driving bans.

City Branches: The eight remaining branches cumulatively are open 205 fewer hours per week than in 2005.

23 Locations: The following libraries were closed on 10/18/2006 for Staff Development Day. Central, Crane, E.

Clinton, E. Delavan, Merriweather, Niagara, N. Park, Audubon, Clearfield, Williamsville, E. Aurora, Boston, JBR, Reinstein, Clarence, Grand Island, Hamburg, Lackawanna, Lancaster, N. Collins, Orchard Park, Kenil- worth and West Seneca. Eden eliminated 3 afternoon hrs. on 10/18/2006 for Staff

Development Day.

Crane: Closed 10/14 and 10/16 due to snowstorm, power outages and driving bans.

Dudley: Closed 10/13 and 10/14 due to snowstorm, power outages and driving bans.

E. Clinton: Closed 10/13 and 10/17 due to snowstorm, power outages and driving bans.

E. Delavan: Closed 10/14 due to snowstorm, power outages and driving bans.

North Jefferson: Library permanently closed on 3/24/06. The Merriweather Library will provide services beginning

4/1/06.

Merriweather: Closed 6 hrs. early on 5/31/06 due to excessive heat and air conditioner malfunction.

Closed 10/13 through 10/15 due to snowstorm, power outages and driving bans.

Niagara: Closed 10/13 and 10/14 due to snowstorm, power outages and driving bans.

North Park: Closed 10/17 because there was no heat in building due to power outages. Riverside: Closed 10/13 and 10/14 due to snowstorm, power outages and driving bans.

Correctional Facility: Closed afternoons on 11/20 and 11/27 for officer training.

Holding Center: Closed 11/15 and 11/16 for officer training.
Alden (Ewell) Free: Open hours reduced by 3 hours per week.

Closed 10/14 due to snowstorm and power outages.

Amherst Libraries: Increased open hours by 14 over 2005 due to additional funding provided by the Town of Amherst.

Audubon: Closed 10/13 through 10/16 due to snowstorm, power outages and driving bans. Clearfield: Closed 10/13 through 10/19 due to snowstorm, power outages and driving bans.

Eggerts/Snyder: Closed 10/13, 10/14, 10/16, 10/17 & 10/19 thru 10/21 due to snowstorm, power outages & driving

bans.

Williamsville: Closed 10/13 & 10/14 and 10/16 & 10/17 due to snowstorm, power outages and driving bans.

Angola Public: Closed 10/13 and 10/14 due to snowstorm, power outages and driving bans.

Aurora Town Lib: Open hours reduced by 14 hours per week, primarily due to closing of West Falls Library. Closed 10/13 due to storm. PCs down 10/13 through 10/19, which affected circulation.

Boston Free Lib: Open hours reduced by 5 hours per week.
Cheektowaga Libs: Open hours reduced by 29 hours per week.

J.B.R.: Closed 10/13 through 10/16 due to snowstorm, power outages and driving bans.

Reinstein: Closed 10/14 thru 10/16 due to snowstorm, power outages & driving ban; opened 10/17 w/ limited svc. Clarence Public: Closed 3.5 hrs. early 10/12; shutdown cont'd.thru 10/17 due to storm, power outages and driving bans.

Collins Public: Open hours reduced by 5 hours per week. Open hours reduced by 3 hours per week.

Delayed opening on 2/17/06 until noon due to inclement weather, lost 2 service hours.

Eden Library: Open hours reduced by 5 hours per week.

Closed 2 hours early on 3/9/06 due to a power outage.

Lost power for 2.5 hrs. on 10/14. Remained open, but circulation was affected.

Elma Public: Open hours reduced by 8 hours per week.
