System-Wide As of January 1, 2007, patrons are no longer required to be in good standing

(per B&ECPL Circulation Policy) in order to use the Internet. In addition, the \$1 fee for short-term Internet privileges is discontinued. The combination of these factors has resulted in increased overall public computer usage.

Audubon Closed early 12/18/2007 due to a roof leak.

Closed 12/12/2008 due to winter storm.

Use of Envisionware PC Reservation System replaces use of PAC-Man Public Access Computer Statistics. Reports from Envisionware show an increase in the number of computer sessions because multiple sessions by the same user on the same day are counted individually while in PAC-Man, they were counted as one session. Envisionware reporting is more accurate.
