

## Accessing EBL Ebooks at the Buffalo & Erie County Public Library

To access EBL Ebooks, you will need a library card in good standing. Log in using your library card and pin numbers.

Once you are logged in, you can search the EBL Catalog using “Quick Search,” “Category,” and “Advanced Search” options, or view the full catalogue. You can add titles of interest to “My Collections”-- a permanent feature that can be viewed in later sessions.

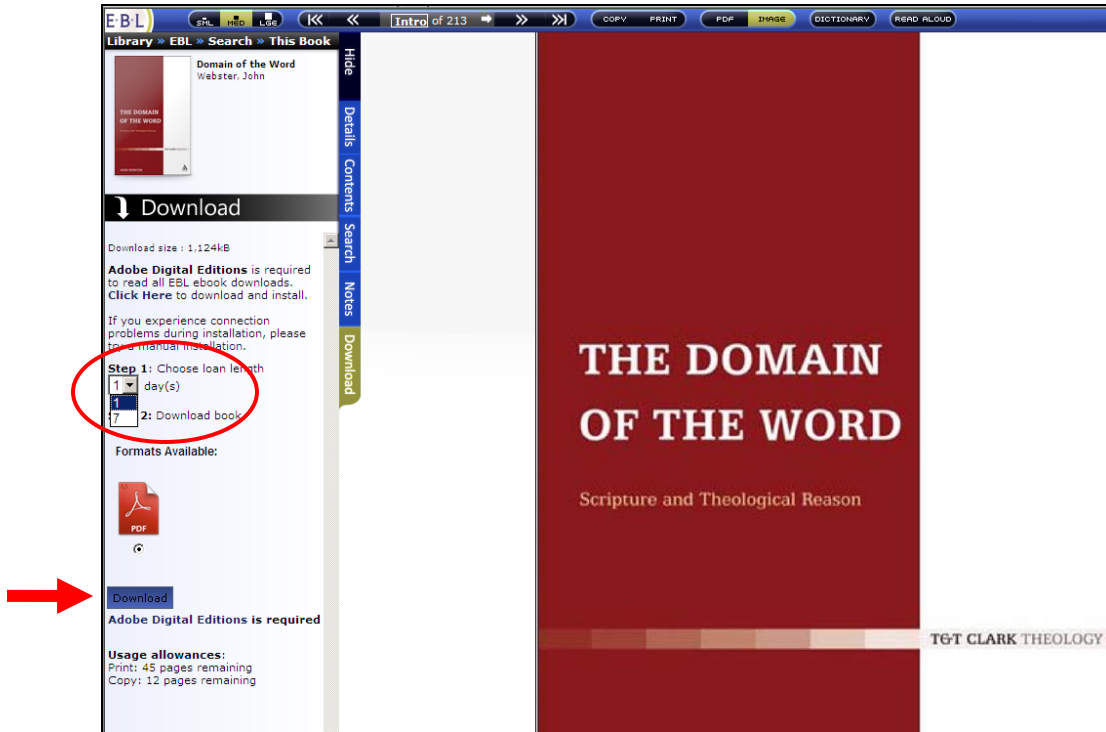

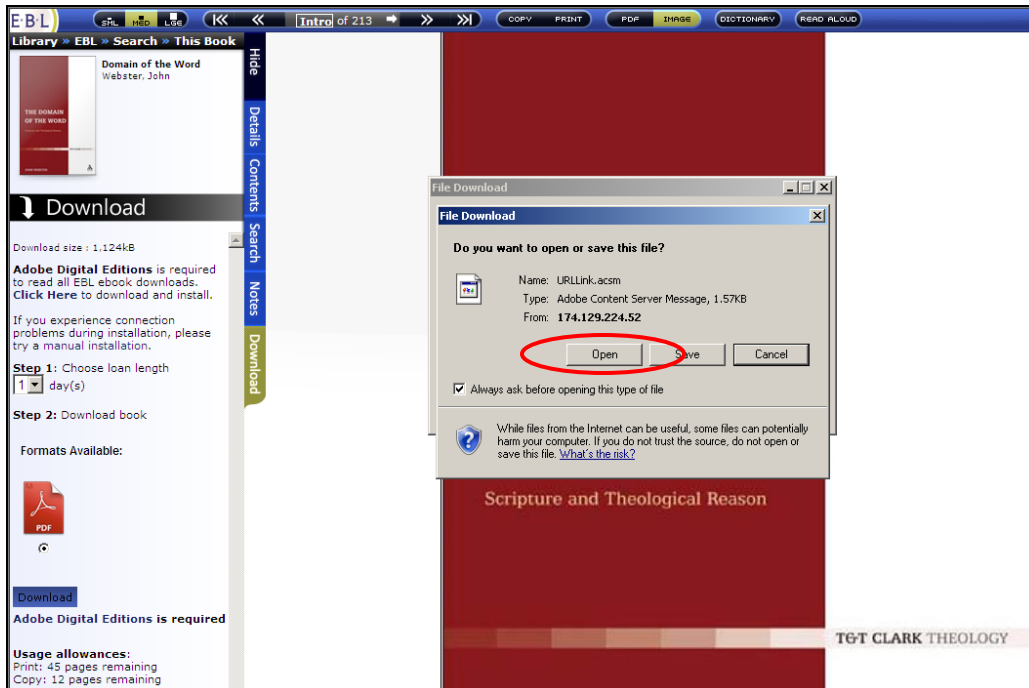
You are now able to view the Ebook starting with an index of Contents that will move you through the Ebook. Click on the “Download” tab to check out the Ebook.
