- 2) Music downloaded: Estimated Retail value for Apple iTunes Store: \$.69, \$.99 and \$1.29 each
- 3) Videos borrowed: 2 night Redbox rental (movies borrowed from the library are free for 7 days)
- 4) CD's Borrowed: Average price of Billboard's 5 albums of 2015 from Amazon, Target & Walmart
- 5) WiFi Session: compared to GogoAir.com \$5 per hour; similar cost to purchase item at coffee shop, etc. while using WiFi
- 6) Online Databases: Average cost to obtain a copy of full text article from database site. For those online resources that provide full text articles, average cost is \$15.00. In many cases only citation is available. (Elsevier, Jstor)
- 7) Programs attended: compared to the cost for an afternoon matinee at Regal Cinema - Elmwood Center, Buffalo, NY
