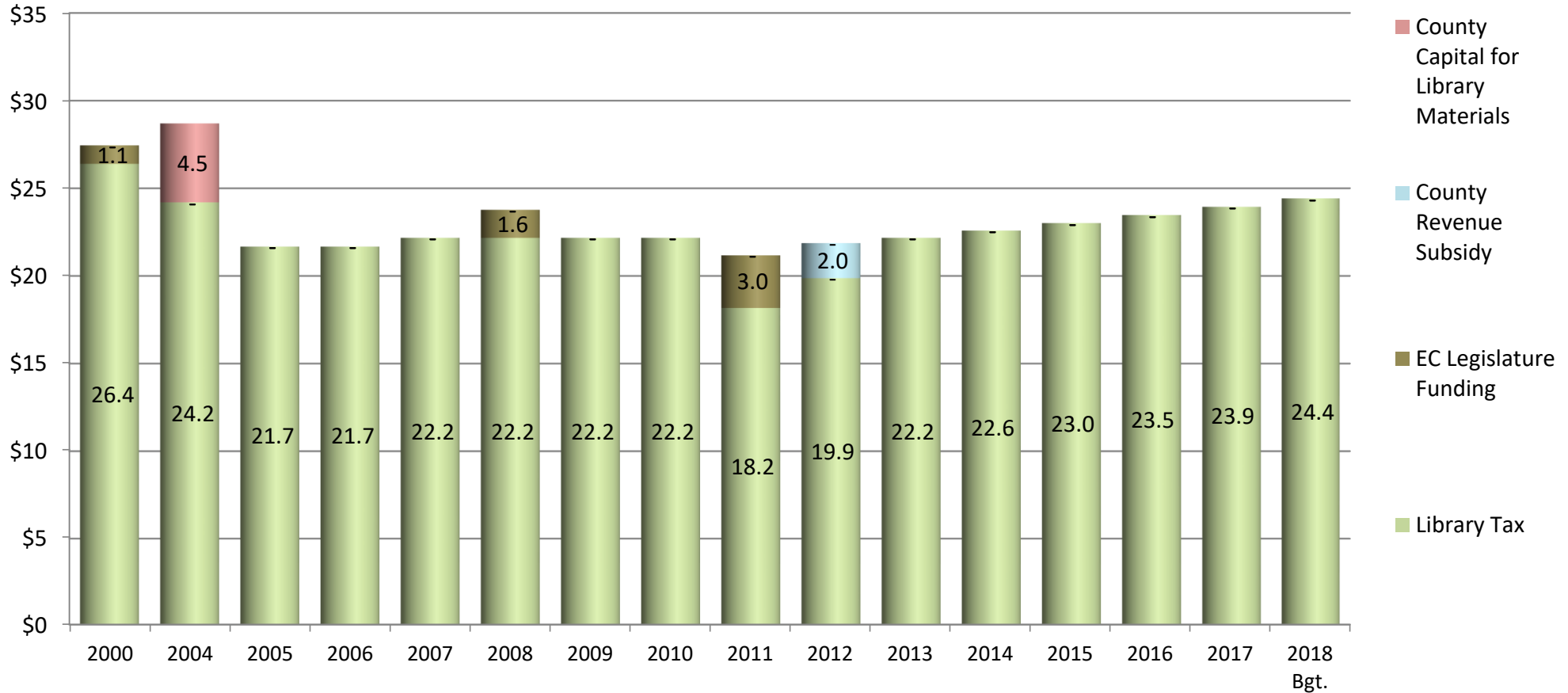

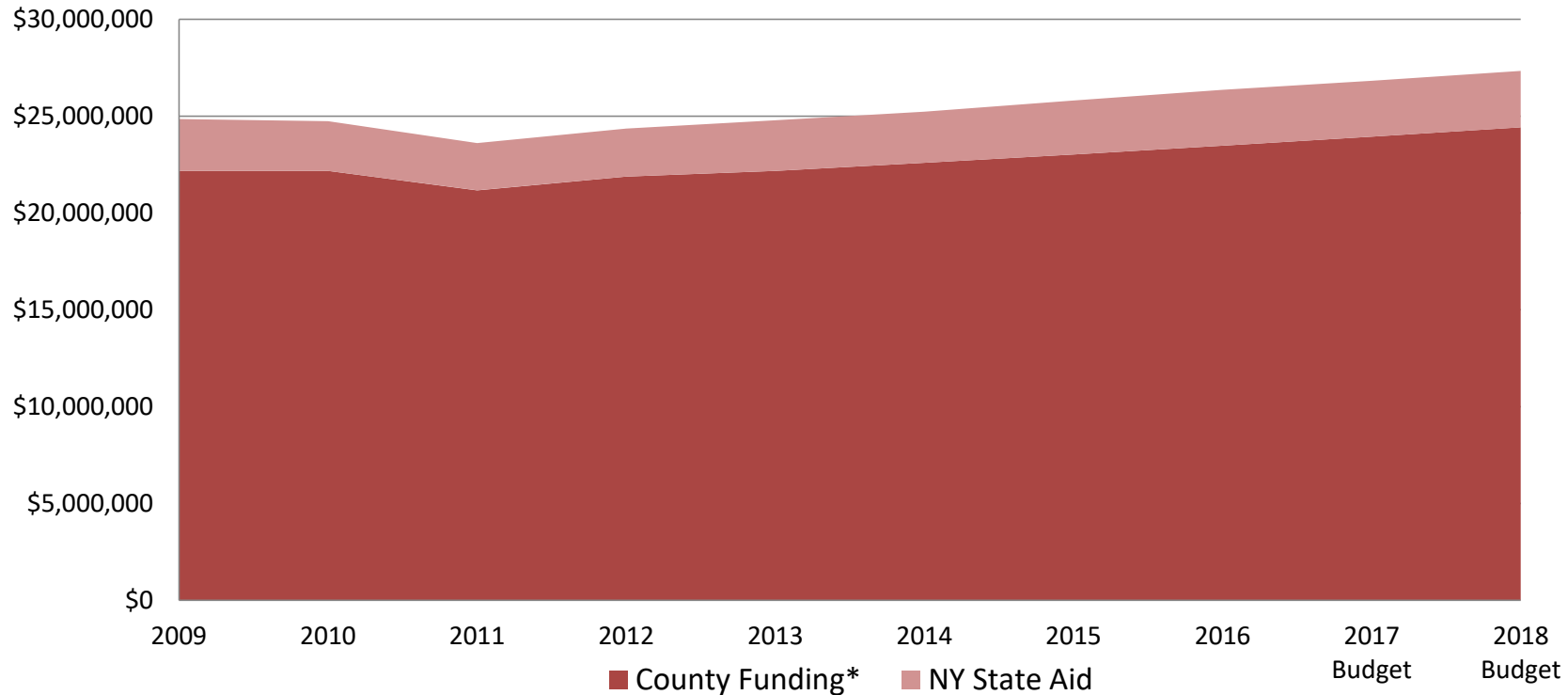

Since 2009, County and State Revenue Up 10%, Consumer Price Index Up 18%



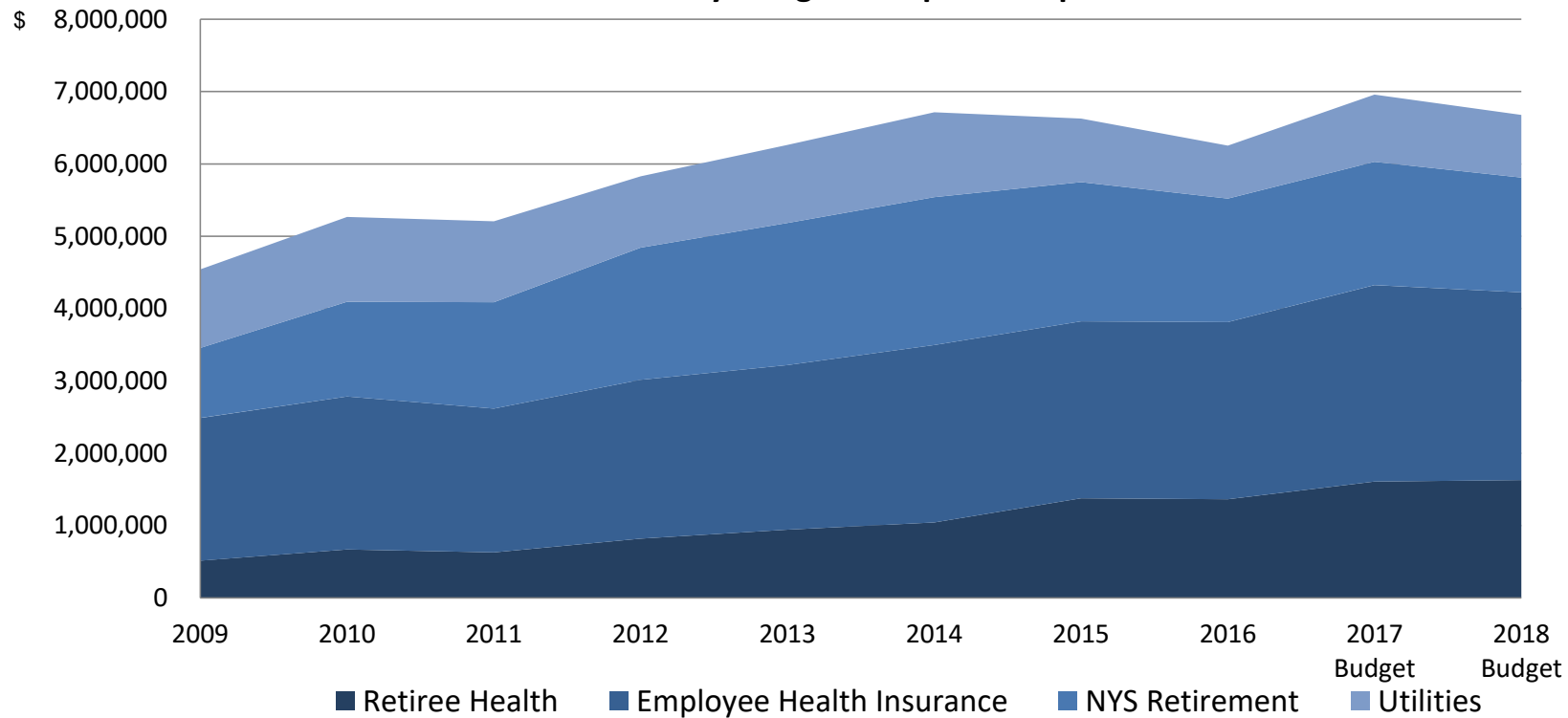

Funding Stress Caused by Previous Years' Revenue Cuts and Contractually Obligated Cost Increases

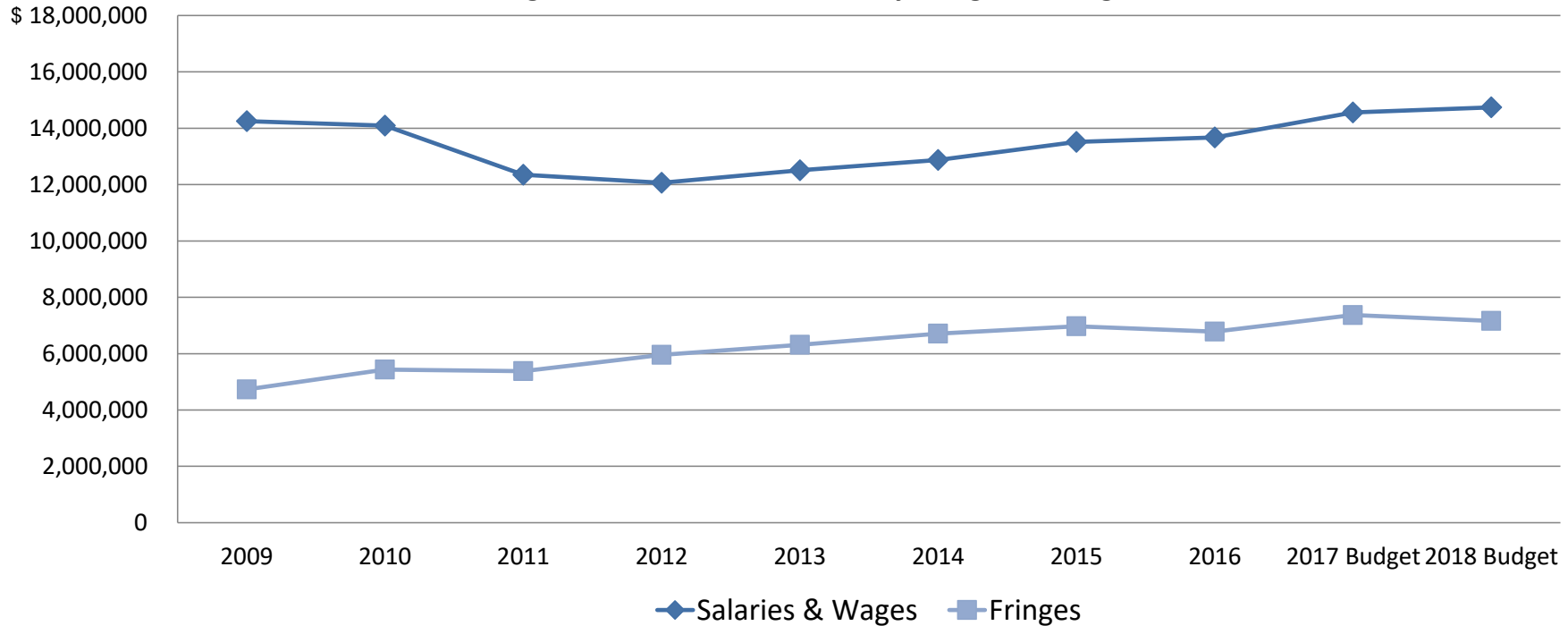

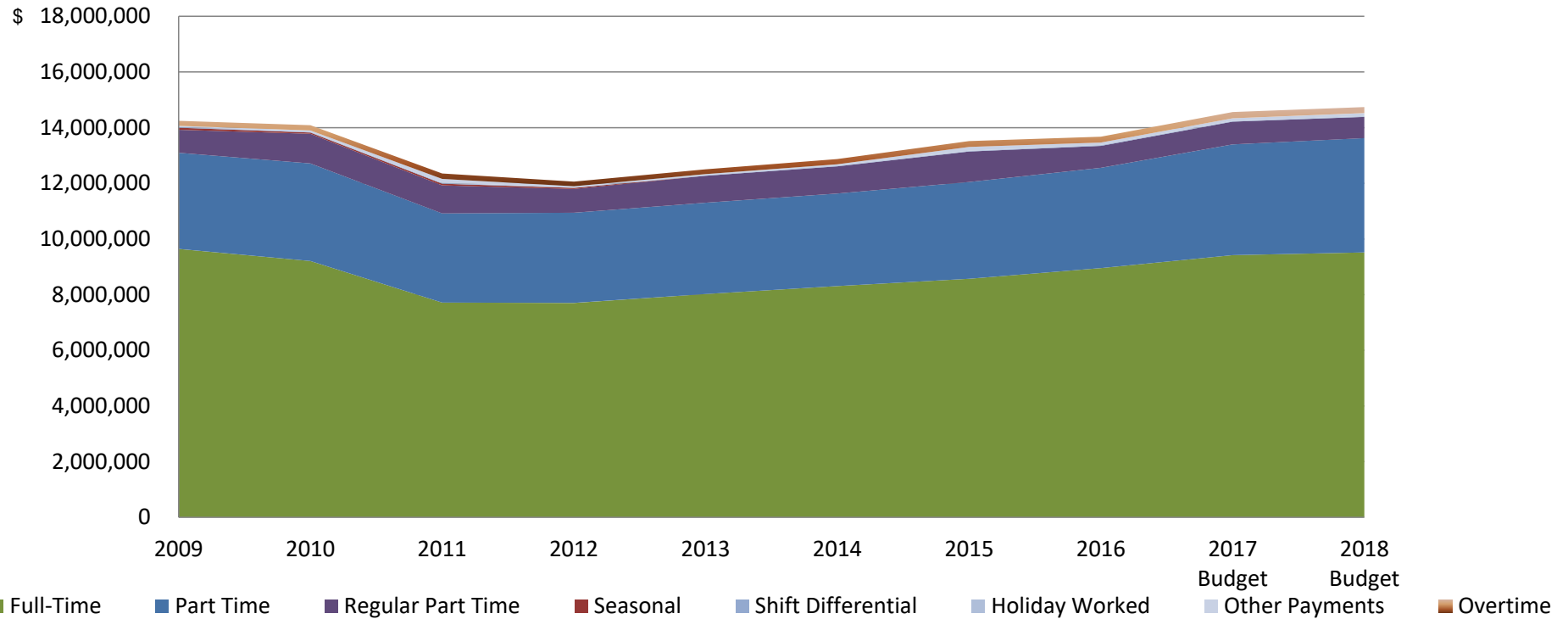

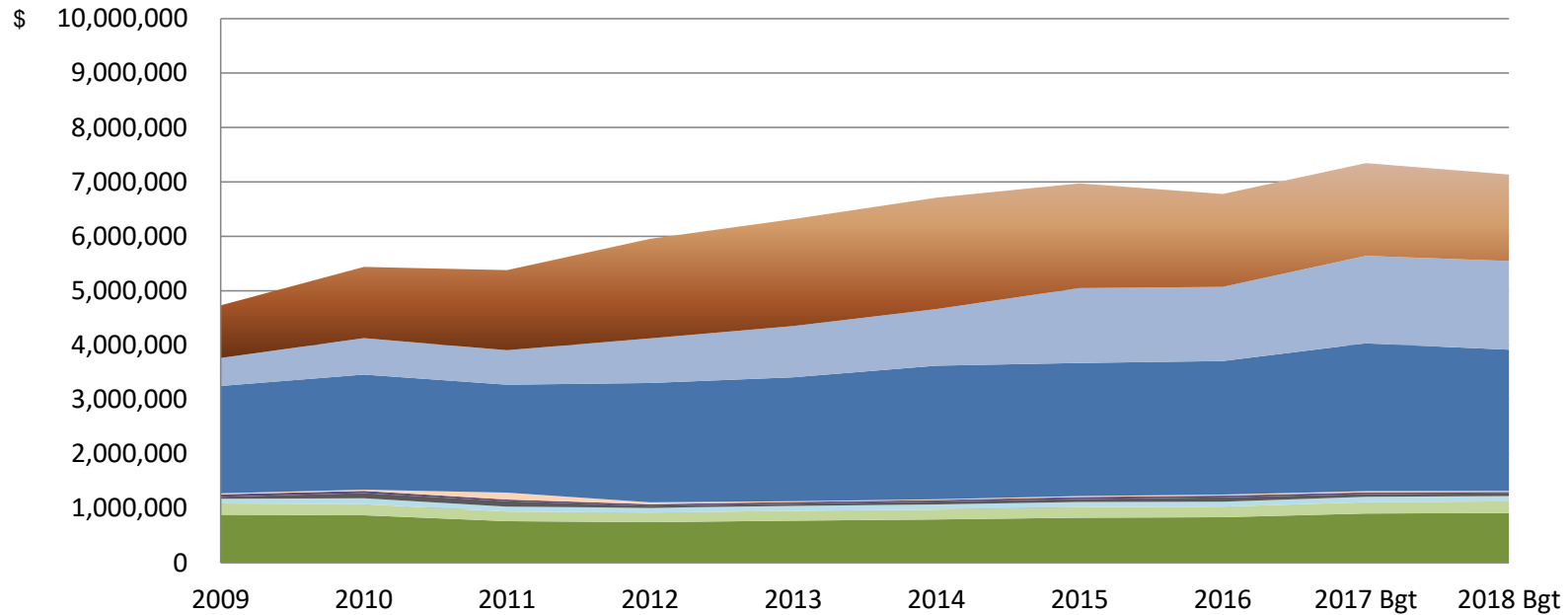

Buffalo & Erie County Public Library Operating Budget* Contractually Obligated Fringe Benefit Trends

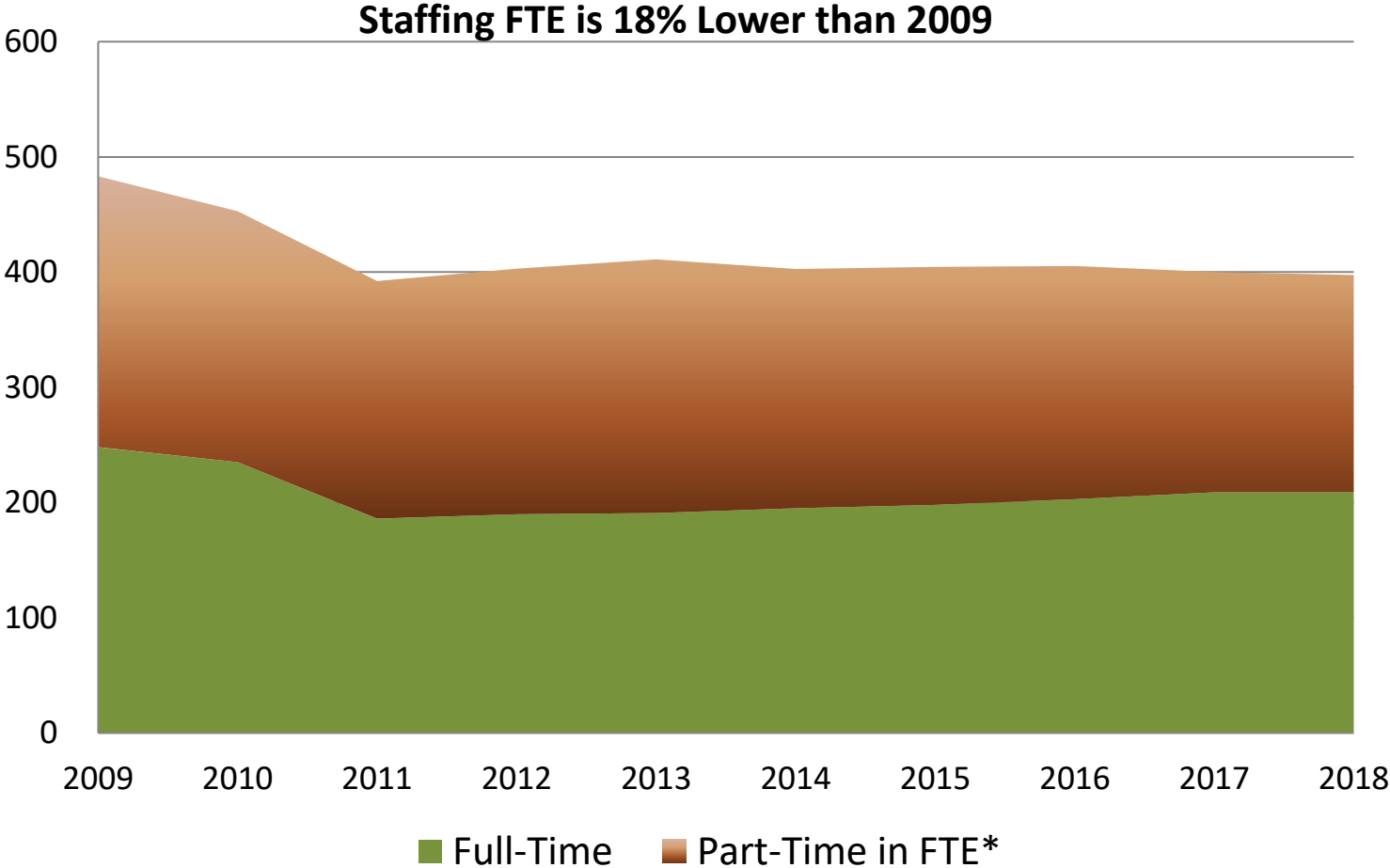

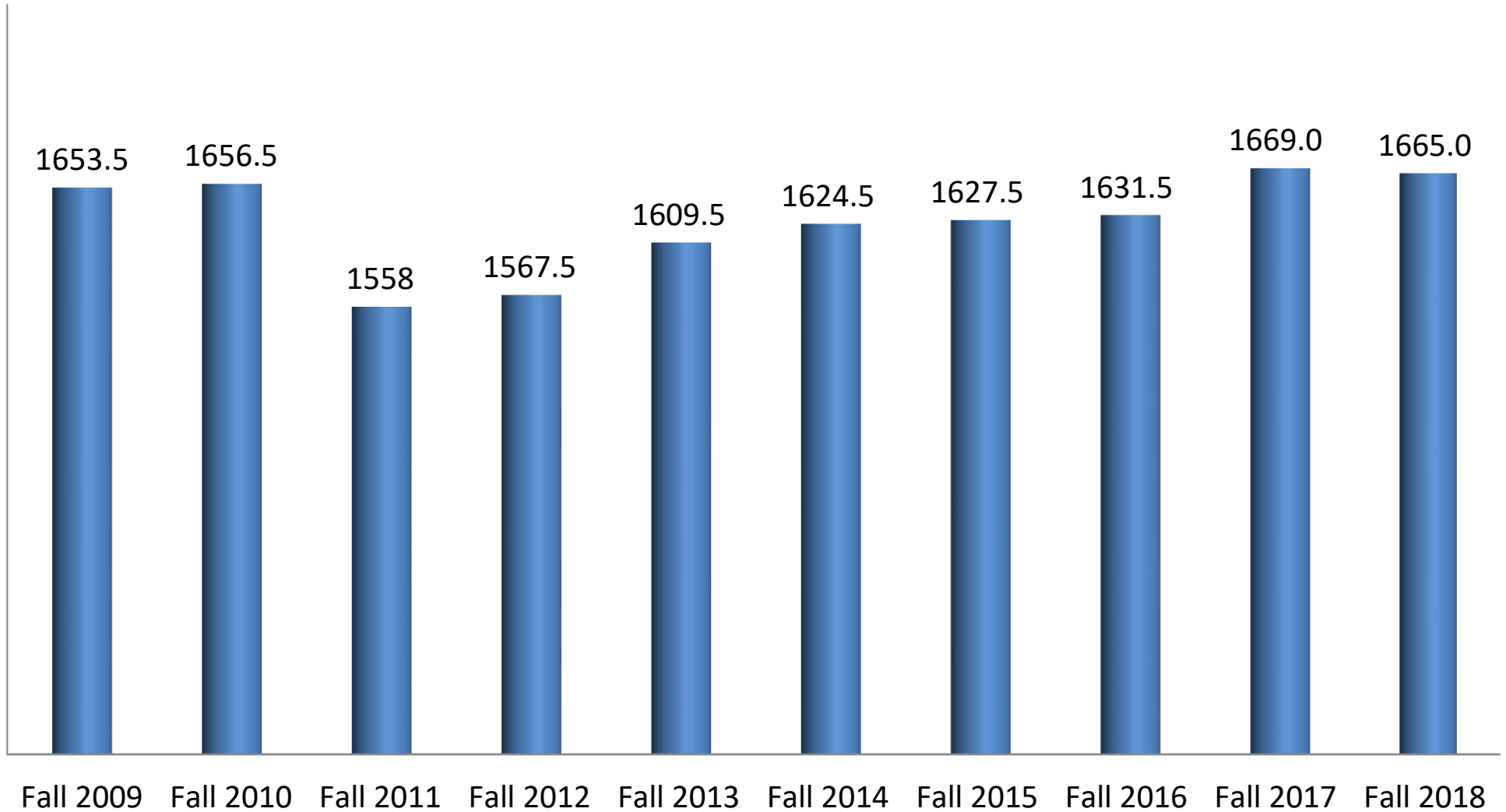
Buffalo & Erie County Public Library Staffing Trends in Full-Time Equivalents (FTEs)

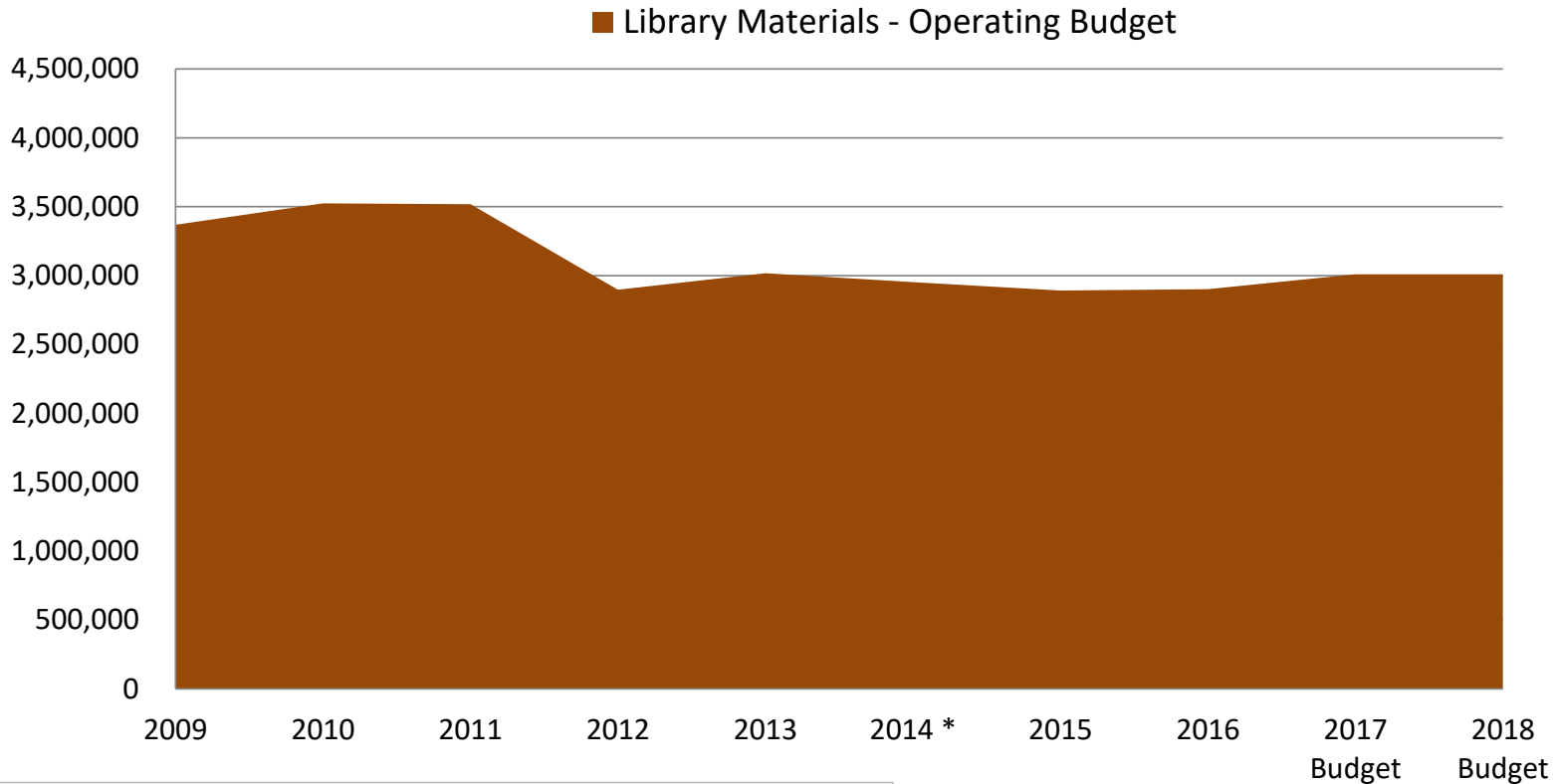
Weekly Open Hours Trends

Library Materials Funding for Purchase of New Books, Media, and Downloadables/Streaming (e-Books/Audio Books, Music, and Video)

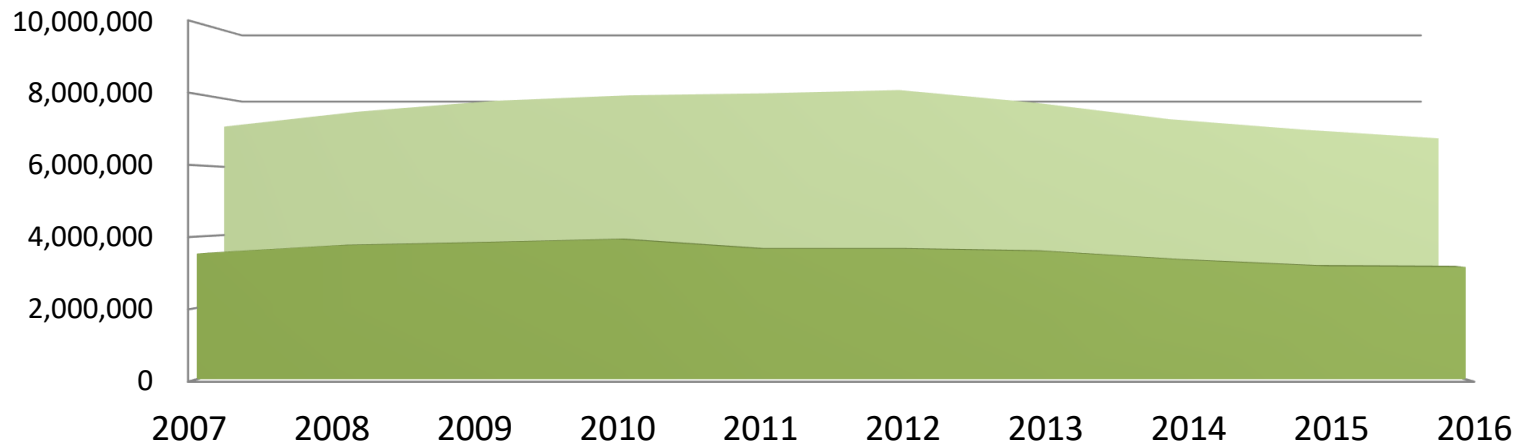

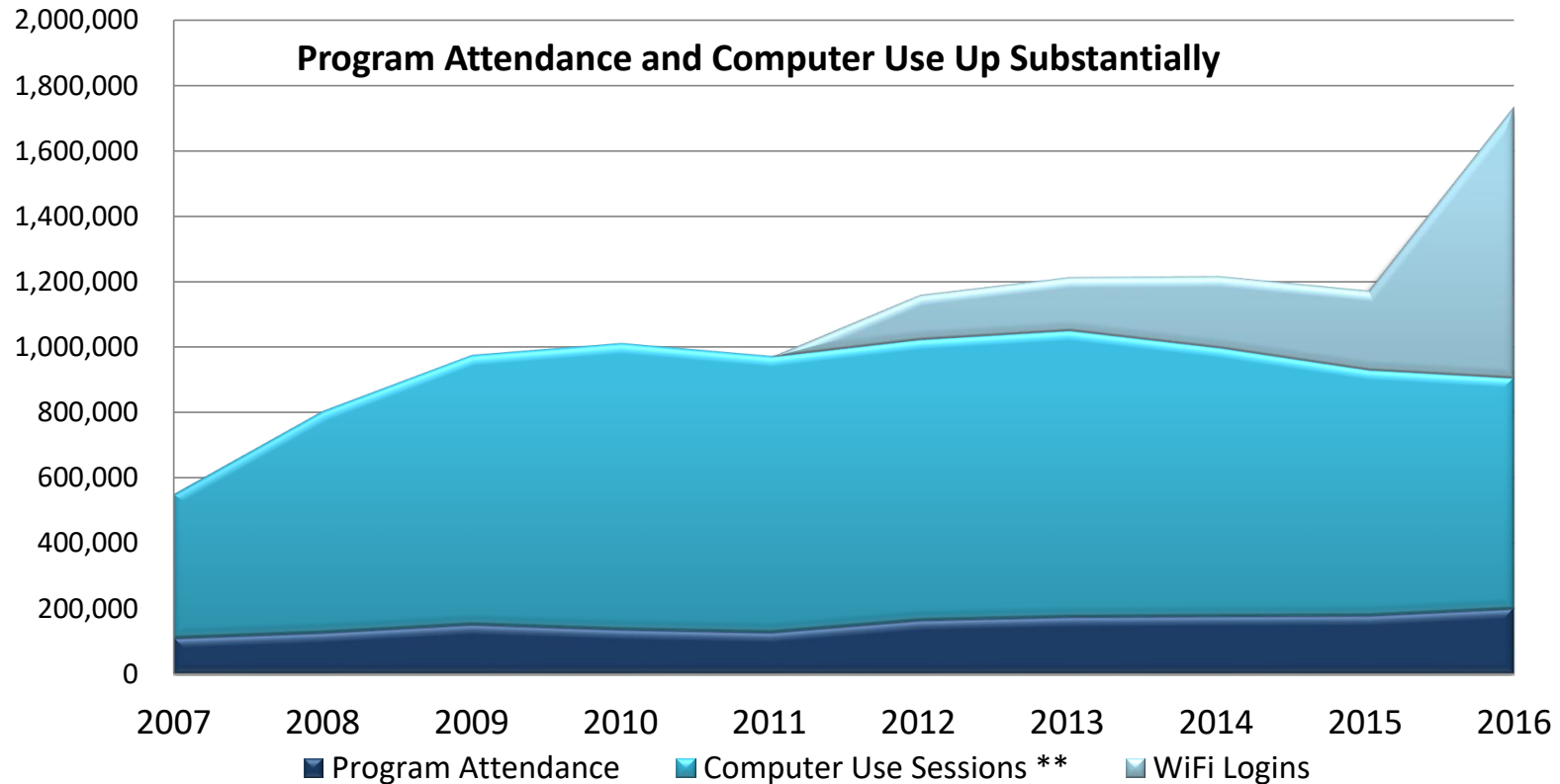

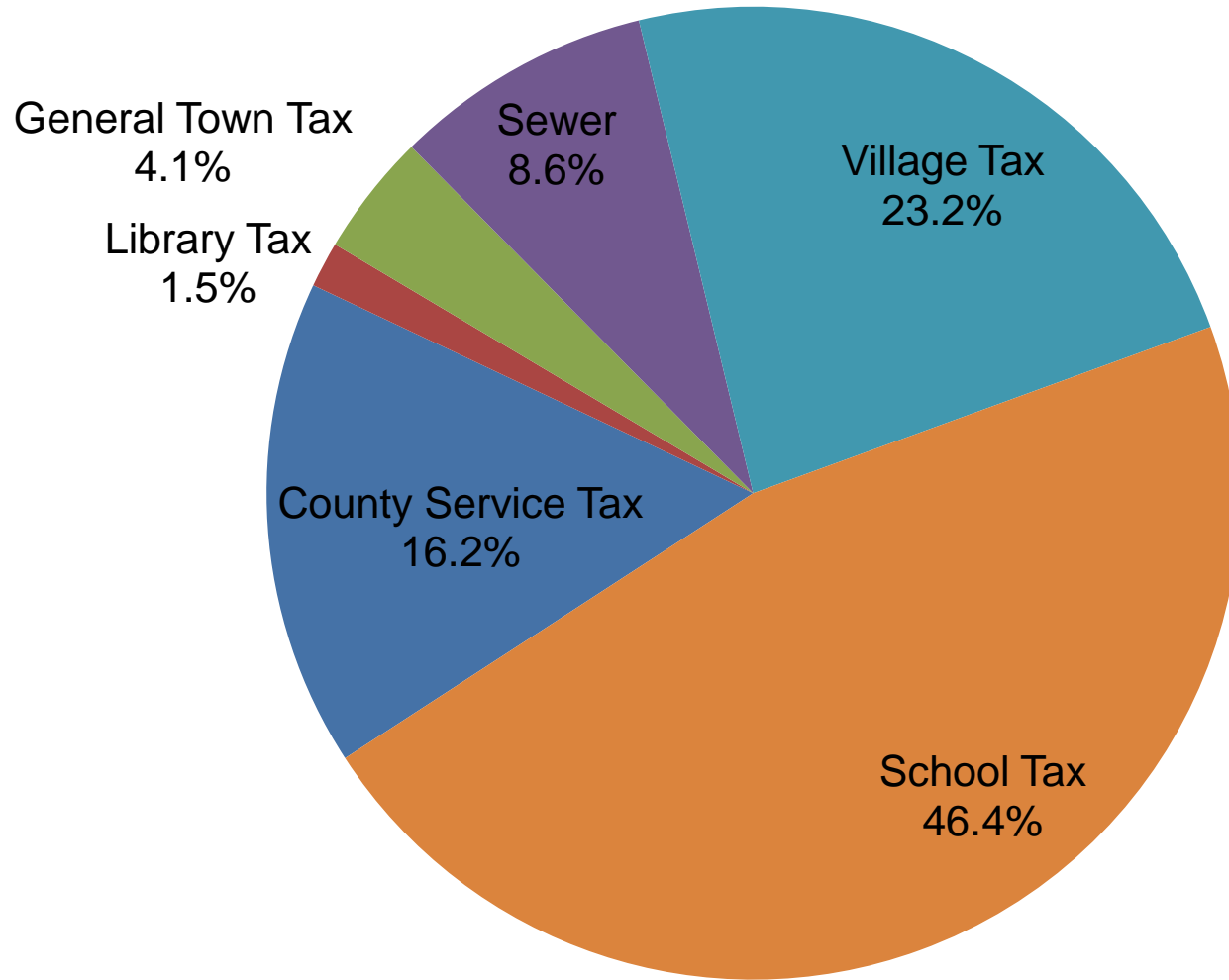

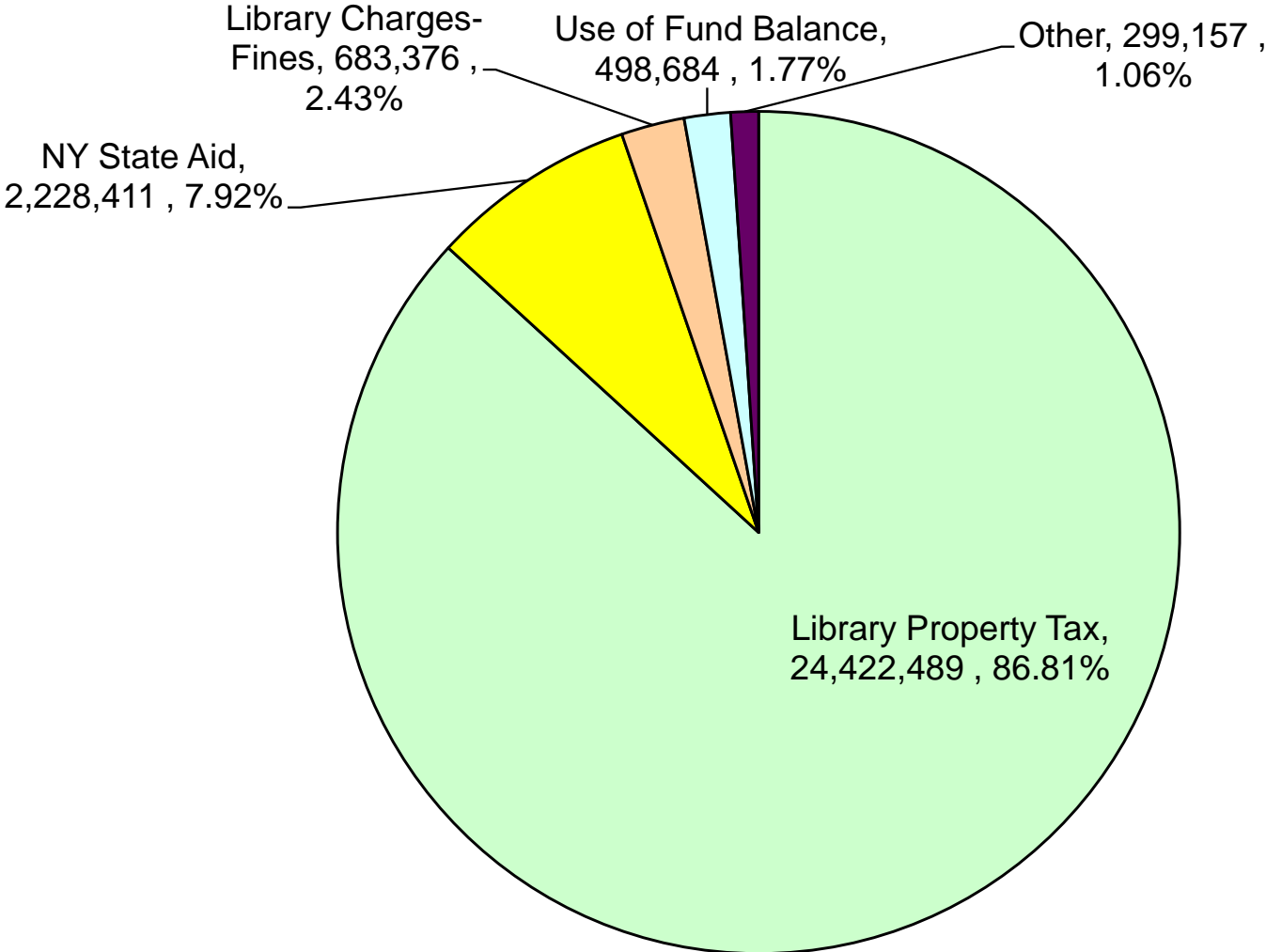

The Library's Share of a Typical Property Owner's Taxes is Very Small



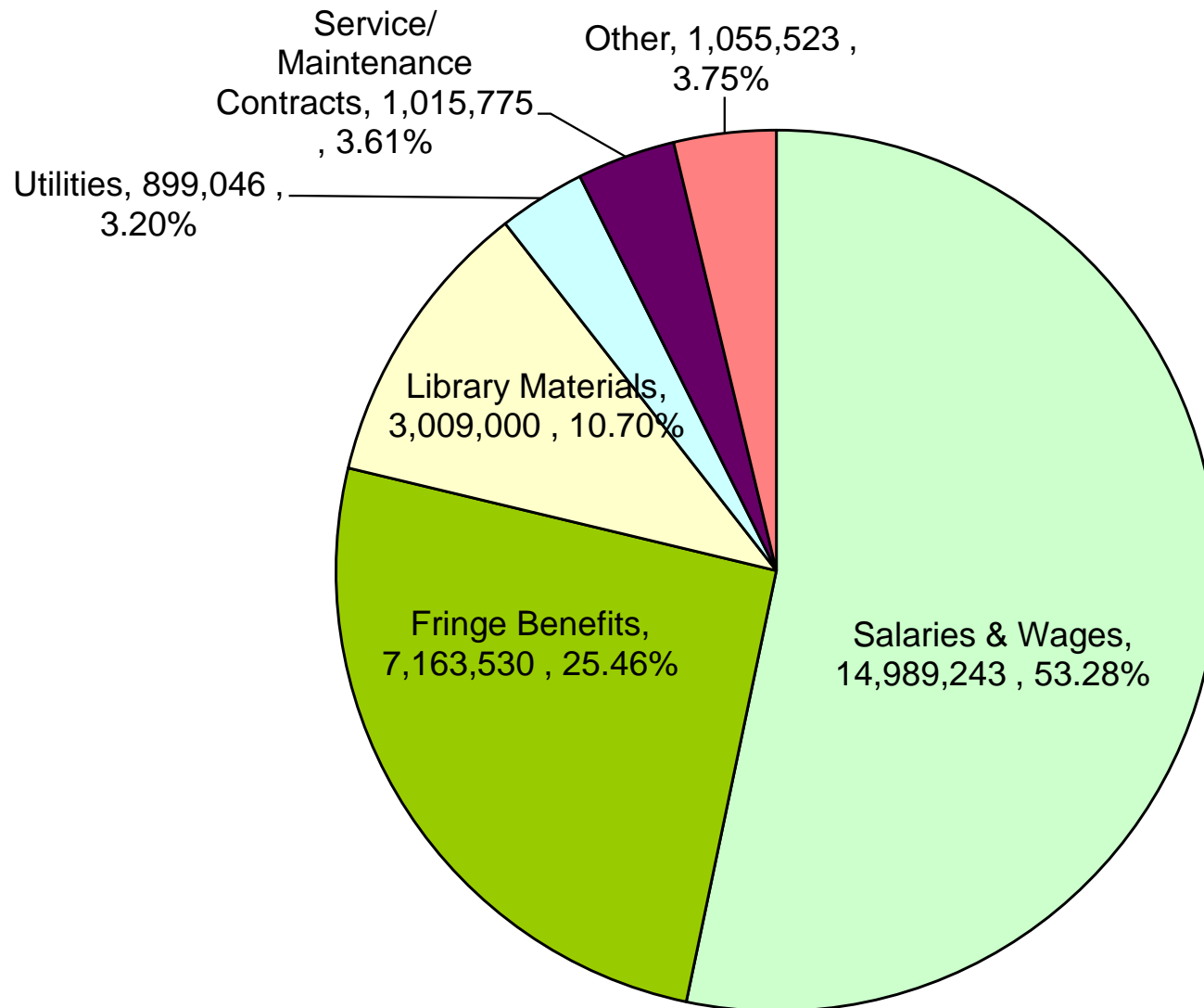

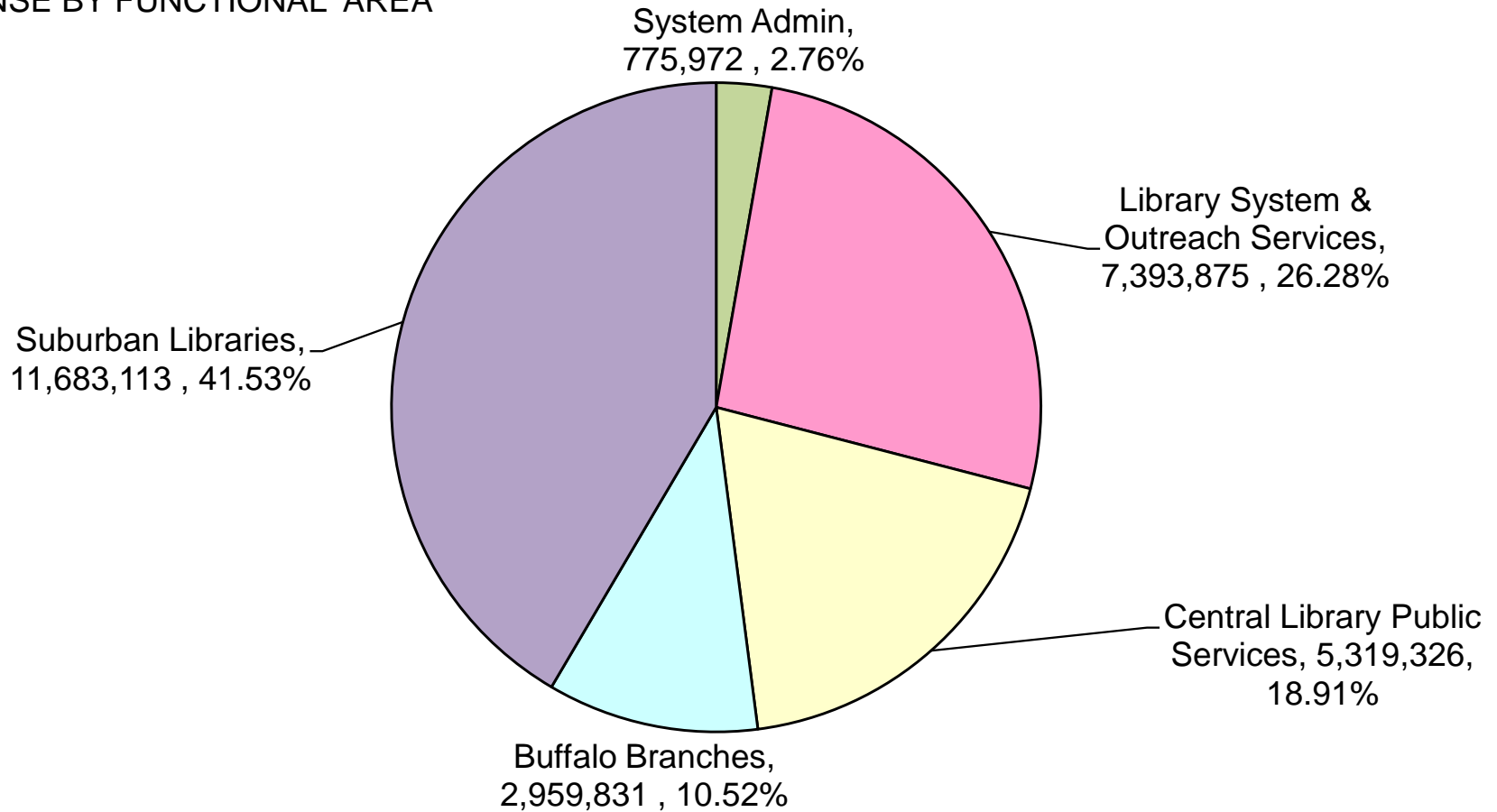

Your Buffalo & Erie County Public Libraries add to the quality of life in our great community. On an average day, 11,244 people use one of the 37 branches of the Library System. That accounts for more than 3.15 million visits in 2016.
