East Delavan Brch: Closed 8/31/05 due to a power outage.

Mobile Services: In preparation for implementation of new Mobile Services in fall 2004, library services on the Bookmobiles,

RAM Van and Lookie Bookie were curtailed beginning in June 2004.

North Collins Public: No storyhours were conducted in August, causing a decline in circulation.
