SYSTEM-WIDE: Several libraries reduced operating hours in 2006 due to budget cutbacks. These reductions are in addition to service hour reductions that occurred in January 2005. Fewer service hours affected circulation at many libraries. Refer to January 2006 circulation report for details of service hour reductions at individual locations.

Concord Library: Delayed opening on 2/17/06 until noon due to inclement weather, lost 2 service hours.

Clarence Public: Opened 4 hours late on 2/8/05 due to a power outage.
