Public Access Computer Statistics

September Footnotes

2010

System-Wide

The number of public access computers available at each library is reconciled on a semi-annual basis. The January 2010 count included public access laptops and stationary workstations. Beginning June 2010 public access laptops are counted separately.

9/22/2010

System-Wide

Majority of libraries closed morning due to Staff workshop.

Alden (Ewell Free)

Major road construction in front of library; no parking in front of library.

Clearfield

Did not open Sundays in September as in previous years.

e-Branch

Downloadable music started September 2010.

Elma Public

Began Sunday hours on 01/10/2010.

9/13/2010

Building addition and parking lot construction began significantly reducing parking and access to building.

2009*

9/17/2009

North Park

Library re-opened in temporary location at 975 Hertel Avenue

9/23/2009

System-wide:

Most libraries closed on 09/23/2009 for Staff Development Day. Elma, Kenmore, Lackawanna, Newstead and Reinstein Memorial Library maintained regular hours; Audubon, Clearfield, Eggertsville, Julia Boyer Reinstein, Lancaster, North Collins and Orchard Park were open in the evening.

4/09-10/09

Aurora

Main Street in Aurora undergoing huge reconstruction. Street in front of library has been closed to traffic, water shut off and programs have been canceled due to street issues. This is expected to continue until October 2009.

Orchard Park

Open three additional hours per week beginning May 26, 2009

System-Wide

A determination was made that all PCs in the public venue will be counted as Internet-able PCs.

All PC counts were updated in February 2009.

City Branches & Central

A formula error impacting February 2007 and February 2008 year to date totals was found in February 2009. This error understated results for both years (actual activity was higher than previously reported). Incorrect year to date figures for Buffalo Branches and the Central Library were subsequently carried into 2008 calculations and comparison data. Spreadsheets have been retrospectively corrected as of April 2009.

Williamsville

Open 16 fewer hours per month in 2009

* Youth Resource Center computers were added to all locations during Fall 2001. These computers do not require registration before use and are not tracked in these statistics. Therefore, juvenile computer use statistics are underreported.
