CONTEST RULES

Classroom Contest Participants

Teachers may sign up their classes up under their own name. You do not have to include each child under a separate account. (ex. Mrs. Smith's 1st Period English). Book reviews are not required to win the grand prize for classroom entries. The classroom winner will be chosen at random from among those registered.

Book Reviews

Should you decide to include reviews for your classroom entry, please have your students write a **BRIEF** book review for each title submitted. Students are welcome to read picture books, fiction, non-fiction, and graphic novels. Print, e-books, and audiobooks are all acceptable formats

What MUST be Included

Title and author of the book

A brief description of the book. What's it about?

Did you like the book...Why or why not? Would you recommend it to others?

What NOT to Include

Profanity, obscenities, or spiteful remarks

Any personal information including phone numbers, mail addresses, or URLs

The library reserves the right to edit or remove reviews that do not follow these guidelines.

If you participated in our Summer Reading Contest you will have to create a new profile with a new user name and password for the Winter Reading Contest. All participants' records are deleted shortly after the conclusion of the contests each season

Participation Rules

This contest is open to classrooms, daycares and youth organizations in Erie County. You do NOT need a library card in order to enter the contest
