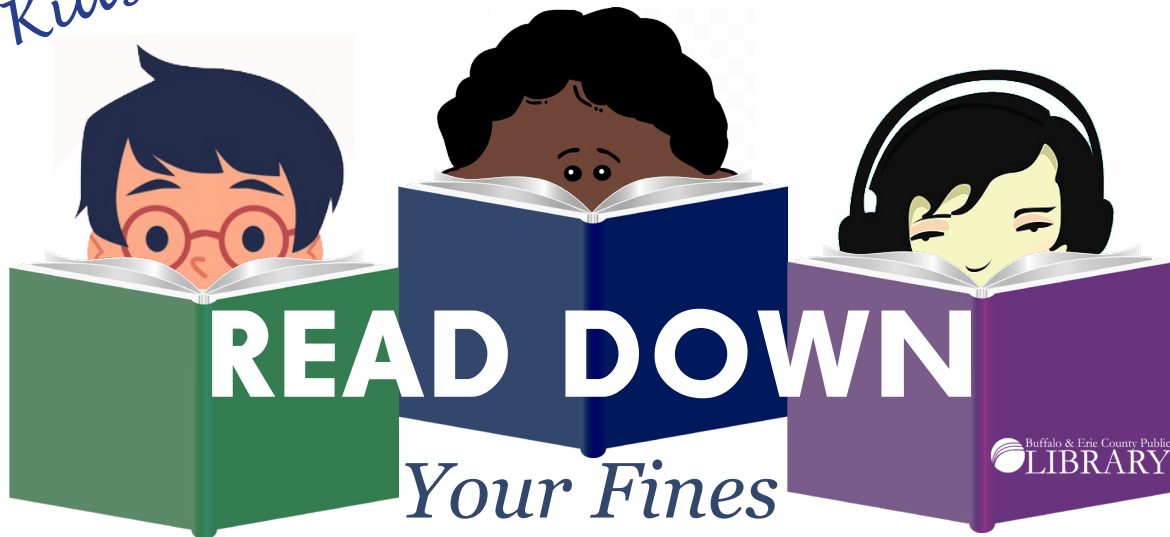

A program designed to bring children/teens (age 16 and under) back to the Library.

Children/teens can use reading as a way to reduce library fines and fees.

- Visit any Buffalo & Erie County Public Library to pick up a Reading Log.
 - Children can erase \$1.00 in fines for every 15 minutes of reading.
- A teen, age 13 – 16, who reads to a child is eligible to erase \$2.00 in fines for every 15 minutes and the child being read to gets to erase \$1.00 in fines for every 15 minutes of listening!
