In addition to a multitude of books, audiobooks, CDs and DVDs, every library has public access computers as well as free high-speed internet and Wi-Fi access. Recognizing that students are attending school in a variety of ways (remote, hybrid, and in-classroom), we have created a *new* STUDENT DIGITAL (LIBRARY) CARD, which provides remote access to B&ECPL's electronic resources including: eBooks, eAudio, homework help tools, databases, virtual programs, downloadable music and so much more! No parental/guardian permission is required to obtain the STUDENT DIGITAL (LIBRARY) CARD and parents/guardians can easily upgrade this library card to a free full privilege library card (for borrowing physical materials and to use the library's internet and Wi-Fi) at the time of application or by coming into any B&ECPL library at their convenience.
