



A menu will open. Simply click your choice to open the desired directory.



## Research an Address

Tip: If you are researching an address do the following:

- Put the address number and street name in quotes in the **Keyword** field. [Don't input the street suffix, for example, Ave., Rd., St., etc.]
- Put the city in the **Location** field.
- Input a year or year range in the **Residence Year** field.
- Make sure all fields are set to "Exact."

All matches for the street address may not be exact in the search results, though all terms entered should be on the page. Keep in mind that Optical Character Recognition may not "read" text correctly.
