Most of the Library's local newspapers are available on microfilm; others are boxed or bound.

Microfilm: New digital microfilm machines allow images to be saved to your flash drive. Printing is black & white, 10 cents per 8.5 x 11 page. Copy cards can be used in 2 of the machines. Newspaper on microfilm will look as the paper did when published (no color; film is black & white only), with headlines, text, images, and advertisements.

Boxed & Bound newspapers must be retrieved from the Closed Stacks. See a librarian for assistance.

RBR papers: For newspapers in the Rare Book Room, an appointment may be required. Please call 858-8900, or see a Grosvenor Room Librarian.

**Don't know the date of an event?** While no complete index exists for WNY papers, here are some resources that can help narrow down the date of an article or event, and often provide an exact citation:

- **1920-1982: Local History Card File**: A selective newspaper index for articles from the Buffalo [Evening] News and the Courier Express. Arranged by subject, the card file has references to local people, places, and events. Provides full citation with the name of the newspaper, date, and page number. Available in the Grosvenor Room.
- **1983-1996: Western New York Index**: Printed indexes that contain citations for Buffalo News articles by subject. Each volume covers one individual year and includes a Personal Names index. Available in the Grosvenor Room and online: <https://nyheritage.org/collections/western-new-york-index>
