INTRODUCTION

This guide focuses on selected sources that describe, illustrate, or document Wright's contributions to Buffalo architecture—the built projects, the never-built projects, and projects undertaken after his death.

This is not a comprehensive list of the extensive Wright-related materials in the Library's collection. Biographies on Wright have not been included; these are located in the Non-fiction and biographies sections of the Central Library.

Most of the items listed here are in the Grosvenor Room (GRO). Material in the Grosvenor Room must be used on the premises and cannot be borrowed.
