Biographical Note

Nelson "Nano" G. Fischer (May 7, 1914—June 12, 1987 ¹) and his brother Arthur "Buddy" Fischer (1917—August 28, 1944 ¹) were born and raised in Buffalo, NY. Both attended Fosdick-Masten Park High School and were active in athletics, including baseball, football, and track. Nelson began his Army service in February of 1941 and married Thelma Hildebrand in September 1941. Thelma (April 12, 1910—February 18, 1992^{1 & 3}) kept a detailed scrapbook of Nelson's time in the army, from1941 to1944. In 1945, after returning home, Nelson became a firefighter with the Buffalo Fire Department. He retired in 1975 ².

Arthur Fischer also served in the Army during the war; he was wounded in 1944 at the Battle of Saint-Lô, France and died in a hospital in Atlantic City, New Jersey shortly after⁴.

The scrapbooks chronicle Nelson's and Arthur's high school sports accomplishments in the 1930s and Nelson's service in the Army during WWII. Photographs of the Fischer and Hildebrand families include professional baby photos and amateur snapshots.
