The *World University Games Buffalo '93 Collection* materials were collected by Burrelle's, a media data service, and librarians of the Buffalo and Erie County Public Library.

Biographical/Historical Note/Chronology

The first international sports competition between student athletes was held in 1923, and, following years of name changes to the governing body as well as the sporting event itself, the International University Sports Federation, or *Fédèration Internationale du Sport Universitaire*, was established in 1948. The games are the world's largest event for student-athletes and the second largest global multi-sport event, second only to the Olympic Games. Held every other year, the games were first held in the United States for the 1972 winter games in Lake Placid.

The games that took place in Buffalo in 1993 were the first summer games held in the U. S. and thus a significant opportunity to draw attention to the declining city.

Scope and Content

The collection contains newspaper coverage from all over the world, as well as promotional materials and publications related to the event.

Series I. The first 4 boxes contain preliminary/promotional and educational materials. Series II. Remaining boxes contain articles on the games from newspapers and periodicals from throughout the United States and parts of the World.
