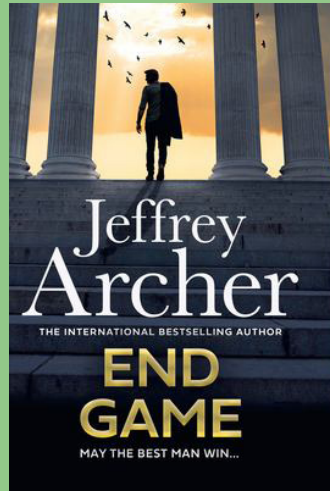
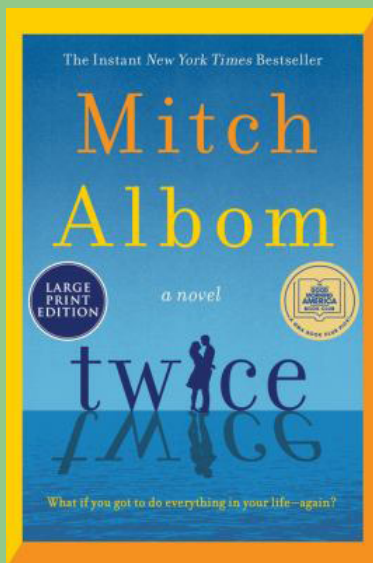
Mrs. Endicott's Splendid Adventure:

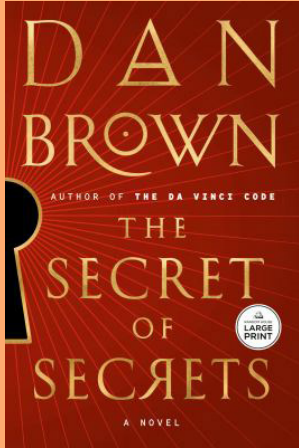

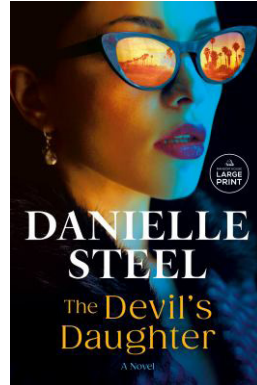
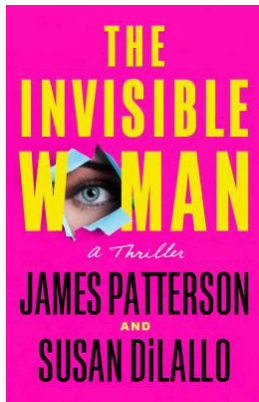
The Secret of Secrets: A Novel by Dan Brown

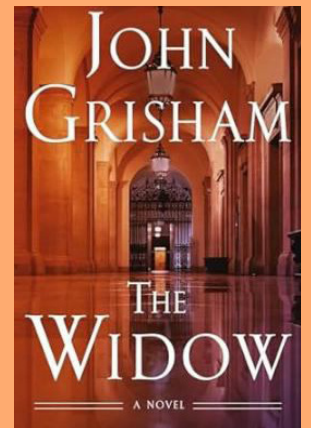
The Devil's Daughter: A Novel by Danielle Steel

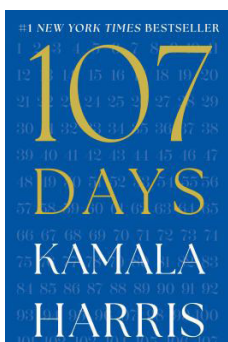
The Widow by John Grisham

Jennifer B. - Librarian, Bookmobile *Unbroken* by Laura Hillenbrand

Louis Zamperini was a fast runner – so fast that he made it to the 1936 Olympics in Berlin, Germany. However, his athletic career was cut short by World War II. His war plane crashed down in the Pacific Ocean. Miraculously, he survived for 47 days drifting in the ocean without food, water, or any means of communication before being captured by the Japanese and sent to a prisoner-of-war camp. This is truly an awe-inspiring book. I found it remarkable that given all that Louis endured, he outlived almost every member of his family, dying at age 97 in 2014. And for some local flavor, WGRZ states he was born in Olean, NY.

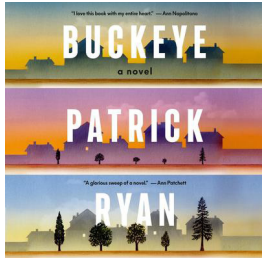

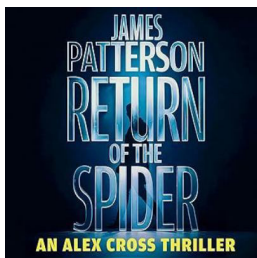
***Buckeye* by Ryan Patrick**

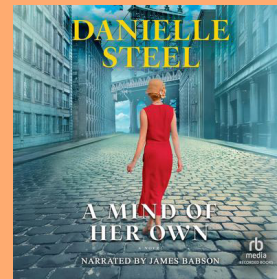
***The King's Ransom* by Janet Evanovich**

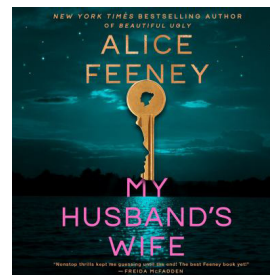
***Return of the Spider: An Alex Cross Thriller* by James Patterson**

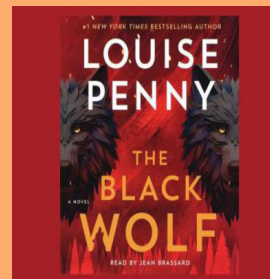
***A Mind of Her Own* by Danielle Steel**
