## New in Large Print



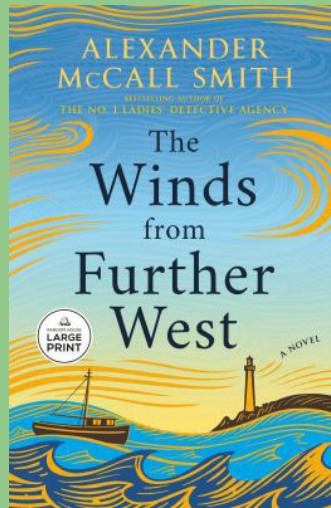
### ***A Moment to Love*** by Tracie Peterson

Feeling that his life is unraveling after being falsely accused of making insensitive comments and

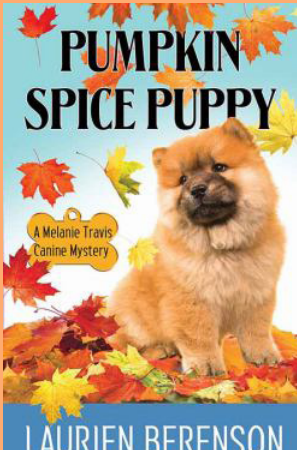

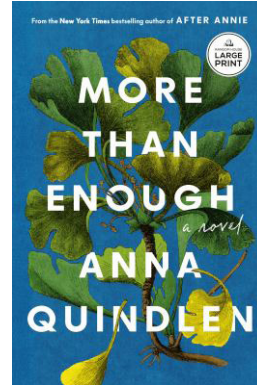
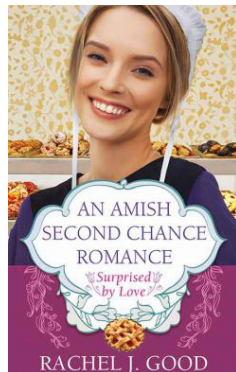
### ***Pumpkin Spice Puppy: Melanie-Travis Canine Mystery* by Laurien Berenson**

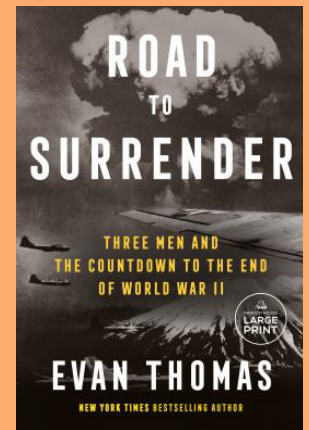
### ***More than Enough* by Anna Quindlen**

they give her an ancestry test as a joke, the results match her with an unknown 16 year-old girl, causing her to comb through her family's history for answers.

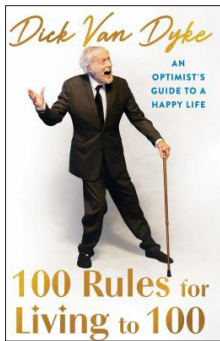
### ***Road to Surrender: Three Men and the Countdown to the End of World War II* by Evan Thomas**

*Weyward* by Emilia Hart

Weyward weaves together the stories of three English women over three centuries. Kate escapes an abusive boyfriend to a family cottage in the English countryside. Altha is on trial for witchcraft in the 17th century and Violet feels trapped in her family's estate during World War II. Patriarchy is the common thread that bonds these women and I thoroughly enjoyed each of their stories. If you are a fan of historical fiction but might want to branch out to fantasy, I am pretty confident that you will enjoy this book. 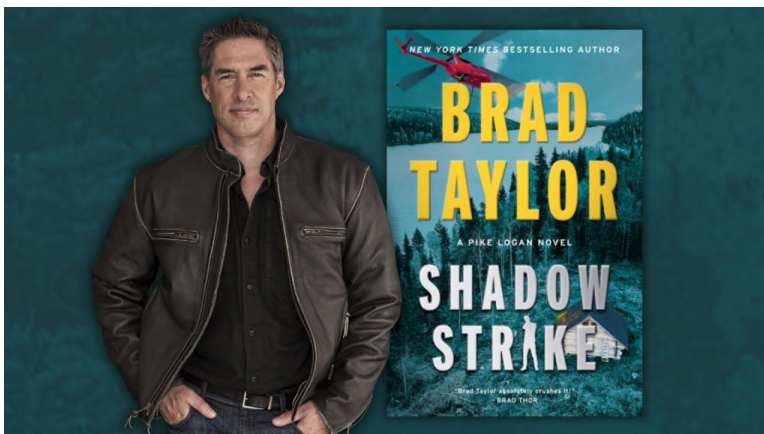
### **Roots & Relax (virtual)**

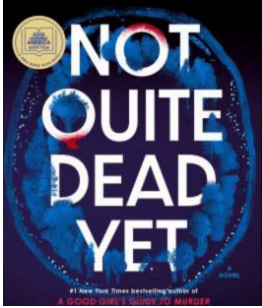

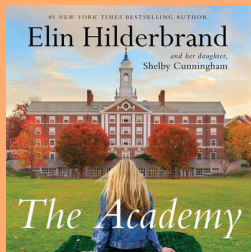

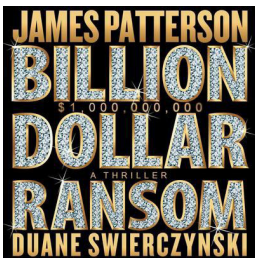
### ***Not Quite Dead Yet: A Novel*** by Holly Jackson

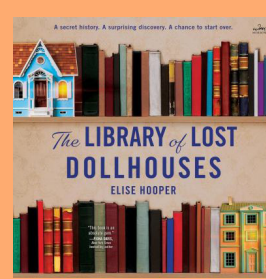
### ***The Academy*** by Elin Hilderbrand and Shelby Cunningham

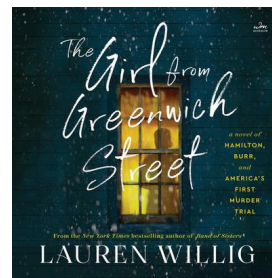
### ***Billion-Dollar Ransom: A Thriller*** by James Patterson and Duane Swierczynski

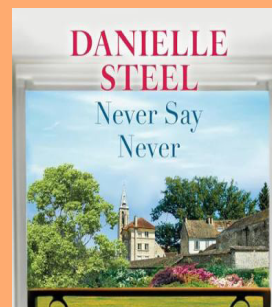
### ***The Library of Lost Dollhouses*** by Elise Hooper

The only silver lining is that it happens in France, where the quiet beautiful surroundings begin to heal her, as does the dog she rescued and a friendly neighbor.
