
This exhibition features special collections of early works including alphabet books, Mother Goose editions, fables, fairy tales and favorite classics!

Checkers Library TV is an educational entertainment program featuring Checkers the


Inventor, his robot sidekick Snoozer, and a variety of special visitors including medical professionals, community leaders, and other special guests in 30-minute episodes.
