The Year in Review

The Clarence Public Library saw an increase in both patron visits and circulation in 2024 (up 7% and 4% respectively), as well as a 16% increase in overall program attendance.

In 2024, the Clarence Public Library received a grant from the Daniel C. and Beatrice M. Fisher Fund to support family literacy and cultural programming and to develop a world language collection. One of our most successful programs of the year was Together with Dia: Day of the Book/Day of the Child which was held on April 20, 2024. The day was filled with crafts and activities for children. Guest readers presented story times in various world languages as children explored different cultures through stories. All children received a free book courtesy of the Clarence Community Foundation.

The Friends of the Clarence Public Library's support last year was invaluable, as their fundraising efforts from their "Friends Place" book store, annual book sales, basket raffles, chicken barbeque and candy bar sales funded most of our library programs and

program supplies and paid for the children's reading nook, shelving in the children's area, and prizes for all of the library's reading programs.
