SEED DONATION PROCEDURE

- Fill out a seed donation form. Copies can be found next to the seed library.
- Pring your completed form and seeds that are in a sealed container (envelope, bag, etc.) to the front desk.
- Seeds must me healthy and clean with all husks, pods and chaff removed.
- Please note that we only accept heirloom and open-pollinated seeds.
 We cannot accept genetically modified, hybrid or patented seeds.
- Open packets of unused seeds can also be donated.
