This was a year that no one could have anticipated.



The year started off strong, the community voted on items to add to the Library of Things, our programs were filled, and we were excited to make things better than 2019.

In March as concerns over COVID-19 increased, we intensified our cleaning protocols and eventually made the difficult decision to close our doors to the public, we still had no idea what would be in store.

When our building closed, we shifted gears, and increased our online presence. We stepped up our social media output, and moved programs online. Our weekly Tod-



dler Time went to YouTube, we did craft programs



with fun activities for kids on Facebook, our Quarantine Cook shook up what we were eating, and our Teen programs went virtual. Our staff shared our favorite books, and

invited our community into our homes.

While not in the building, our staff took advantage of a number of online trainings, bringing us new ideas to better serve our community. Topics included customer service, planning, programming, and updates about the pandemic.

Upon reopening, our library began with a walkup service program, that allowed patrons to call or email for items to be brought outside for them. This program has proven a valuable addition, and continues. Call today to set up a pick up appointment!

While we had made plans for the safest programming we could conceive, rising rates at the end of the year postponed in-person programming. We hope to

be able to bring this back to our patrons soon!

The Board of Trustees has moved their meetings online, still open to the public via attendance and recording, and meets regularly to discuss how



the library can increase health and safety protocols for our staff and community.

Over the summer, we moved our Wi-Fi router, so free, secure, high-speed Wi-fi is always available in and outside the library for your personal devices 24/7. From the library's website, eBooks, eAudiobooks, music, & databases are available free with your library card.

The Library is soon to embark on a long range planning progress, looking at how we can best serve our community now, and going forward.

Over the course of 2020, we held 94 in-library programs, 67 virtual real time programs, and produced 126 recorded programs for Facebook and YouTube.
