Wednesday May 22nd h 1-3 pm **Registration required**

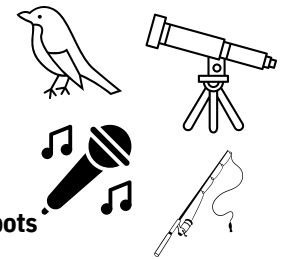
Join us for an engaging session where you'll discover the power of Canva, a user-friendly graphic design tool.
