## A MESSAGE FROM

## **BUFFALO & ERIE COUNTY PUBLIC LIBRARY DIRECTOR MARY JEAN JAKUBOWSKI**

Dear Buffalo & Erie County Public Library patron and supporter:

I hope this finds you well and that you are staying warm on these frigid, wintry days. Here at the Buffalo & Erie County Public Library System, we have been working hard and I am excited to share with you the following updates:

1. **OPEN FOR SERVICE:** ALL 37 Buffalo & Erie County Public Libraries are open for inperson services. View open hours for each library here: <a href="https://buffalolib.libcal.com/">https://buffalolib.libcal.com/</a>

Below are a few things you need to know before your visit:

- Properly fitting facial coverings are required to be worn correctly, by all persons over the age of two, at all times;
- Social distancing (minimum of six feet) is in effect:
  - o Heavily trafficked areas have floor markers;
  - o Furniture and public computers are spaced apart;
- ALL returned materials, including but not limited to books, CDs, DVDs, magazines, etc. are quarantined for a period of four days. Materials returned on time will not accrue fines/fees, but will remain on your borrower record for the quarantine period;
- NO eating/drinking is permitted;
- Hand sanitizer stations are placed throughout the library;
- Plexiglass shields are found at most service desks; and
- We encourage you to limit your stay to two hours.

Every library has its own Safety Plan. For more information, please contact your library directly.



2. **HOLD FEES ARE NOW A THING OF THE PAST:** There is no longer a charge to request an item or place an item on hold. This means you can reserve materials that are on a waiting list or order material from any library in the System and have the item/items sent to your local library at no cost. You will be notified when the item/items are available for pick-up and will have eight days to collect the item/items. In the event materials are not picked up, a per-item fee will apply. - 3. **NEW SERVICE:** We now offer a "Library by Mail" program. This free program was designed for Erie County residents who are temporarily or permanently homebound and unable to go to a physical library. Have questions or need a library card to participate? Give us a call at 716-858-7156.
- 4. **PROGRAMMING**: While most libraries are not yet offering in-person programming, there are hundreds of virtual programs available through our website, social media channels and via Zoom including book clubs, storytelling, family crafts, lectures, wellness classes, genealogy and technology training and much, much more! - 5. **LIBRARY CARDS**: We have traditional library cards, eCards and a new **Student Digital Card** for those Erie County students in grades K-12 who do not already have a library card. A Student Digital Card allows students to borrow eBooks and eAudiobooks, download music and get homework help using online resources such as encyclopedias and magazine articles. 
## 6. OTHER GREAT HAPPENINGS:
