With renewed public interest these days in discovering family history thanks to tools like Ancestry.com, the thought of how to do that research and where to find information can seem daunting. For those wishing to begin that journey, the Buffalo & Erie County Public Library's Central Library at 1 Lafayette Square, Buffalo, will host a free "Family History Day" on Saturday, June 10 from 11:00 a.m.-2:00 p.m.
