For the next six weeks, through Thursday, February 29, readers can participate in this free program by registering, tracking reading time, and submitting short book reviews on the Library System website <http://becpl.ny08.readsquared.com>.

Winners will be randomly selected from all reviews submitted in three categories: kids (ages 0-12), teens (ages 13-17), and adults (ages 18+). Prizes include either a LEGO set, Magna-Tiles, or Soft & Safe building blocks for children; a \$100 gift certificate to Barnes & Noble for teens; and a \$100 gift card to a grocery store for adults. Each of the 37 Buffalo & Erie County Public Libraries will also award a \$25 Amazon gift card to a branch-level winner in the adult category.
