

IMPORTANT NOTICE:

Buffalo & Erie County Public Library patron access to hoopla will end effective December 31, 2025.

Like many libraries across the country, the Buffalo & Erie County Public Library has seen a significant increase in costs for digital materials. Unfortunately, hoopla's pay-per-use model, in which a library is charged each time an item is borrowed, has become an

unsustainable expense for our Library. We were spending over \$1,000 a day! We took measures to reduce the hoopla costs by restricting higher-priced materials for check out; however, the annual expense remains unsustainable.

The Library remains committed to meeting the demand for eBooks and eAudiobooks through our robust OverDrive/Libby collection, which also offers thousands of digital magazines and comics. We will also continue to invest in our physical/print collections to ensure they are current, diverse, and accessible for all.

We appreciate your understanding and patience while the Library makes adjustments so that we may continue providing a Library collection that best serves our community while staying within our budget.

The last day to borrow digital materials through hoopla will be **December 31, 2025.**All hoopla checkouts will be good for their full loan period.
