- Trades/skill training

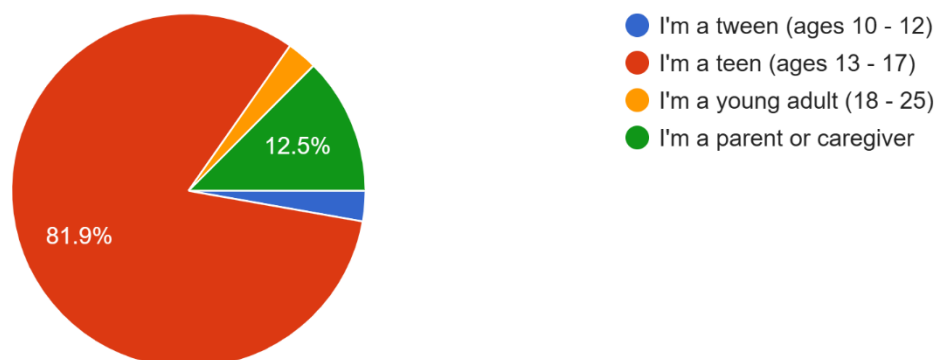
These hands-on opportunities will help youth broaden their awareness of future careers while building the soft skills and technical expertise they need to succeed in the modern workforce!

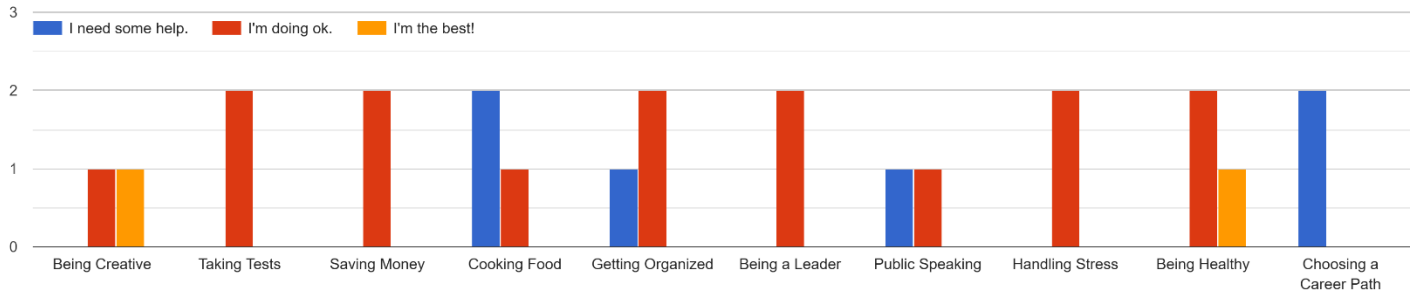
1. What is your interest in library programs for tweens, teens, and young adults at the Aurora Town Public Library?

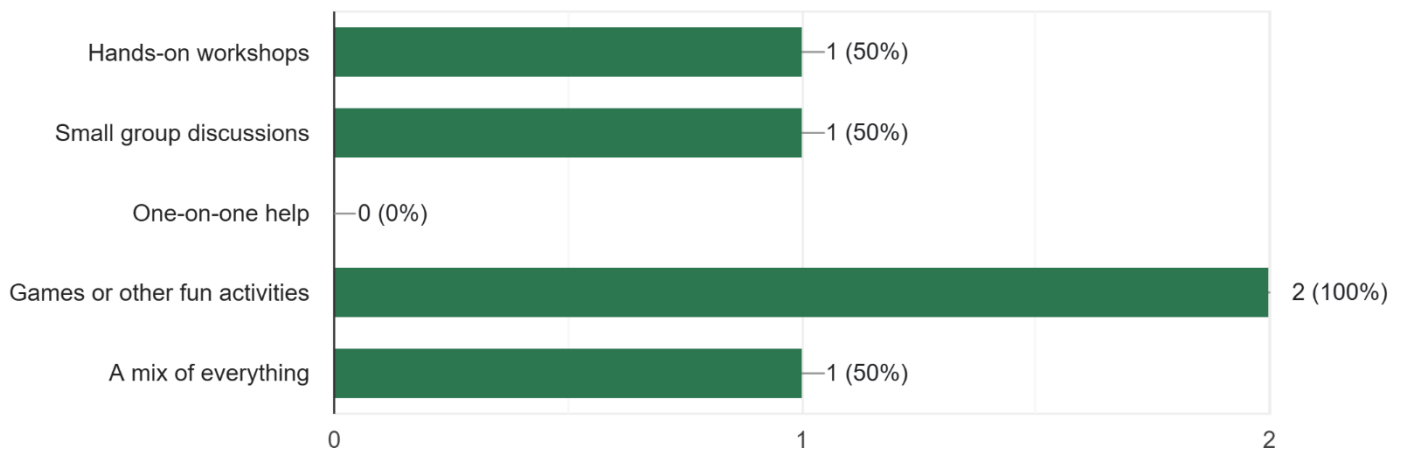

2. How do you feel about your current life skills? Use the options below:

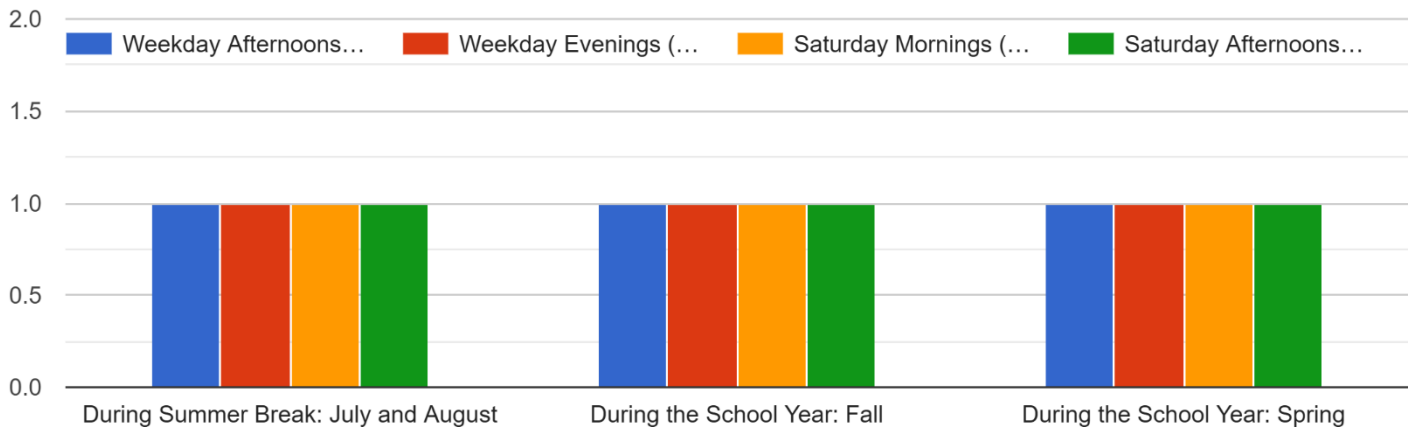


3. What types of activities do you like to do? (Select all that apply)

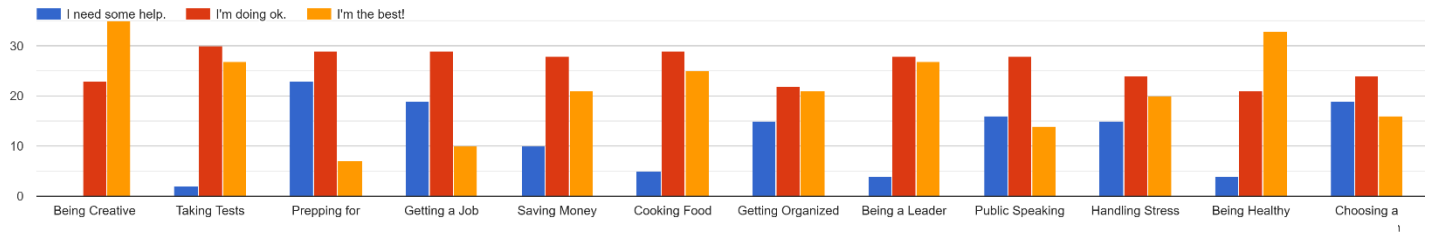


4. When can you to come to programs at the library?



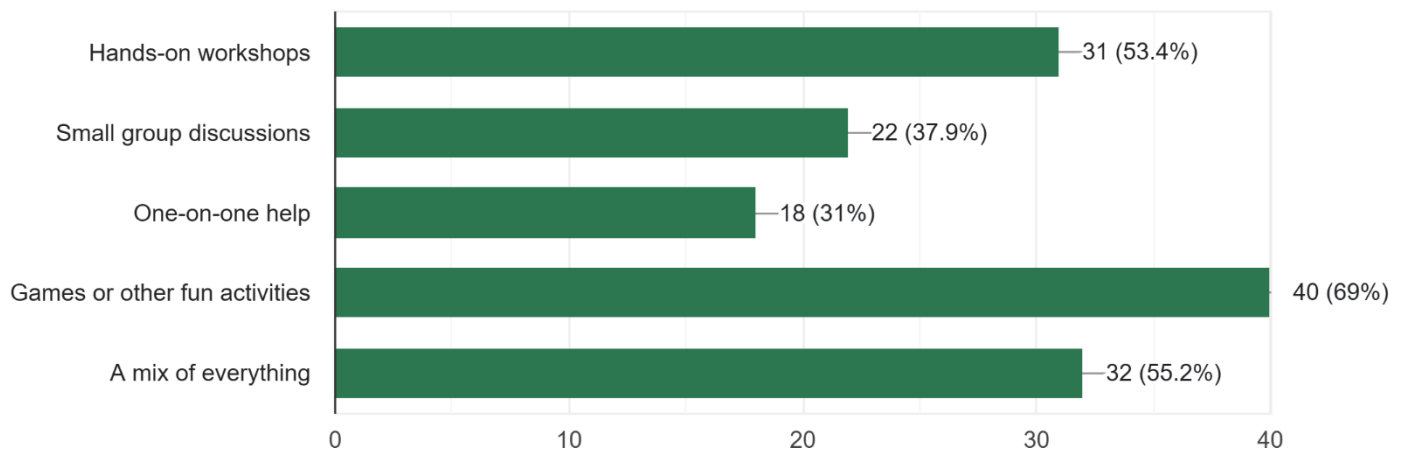

5. How do you feel about your current life skills? Use the options below:

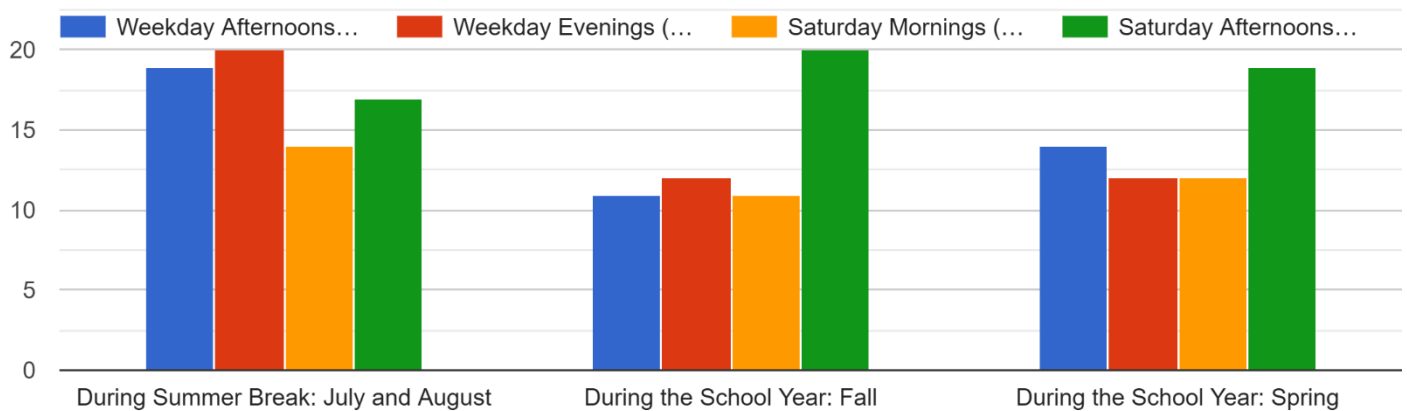


6. What types of activities do you like to do? (Select all that apply)

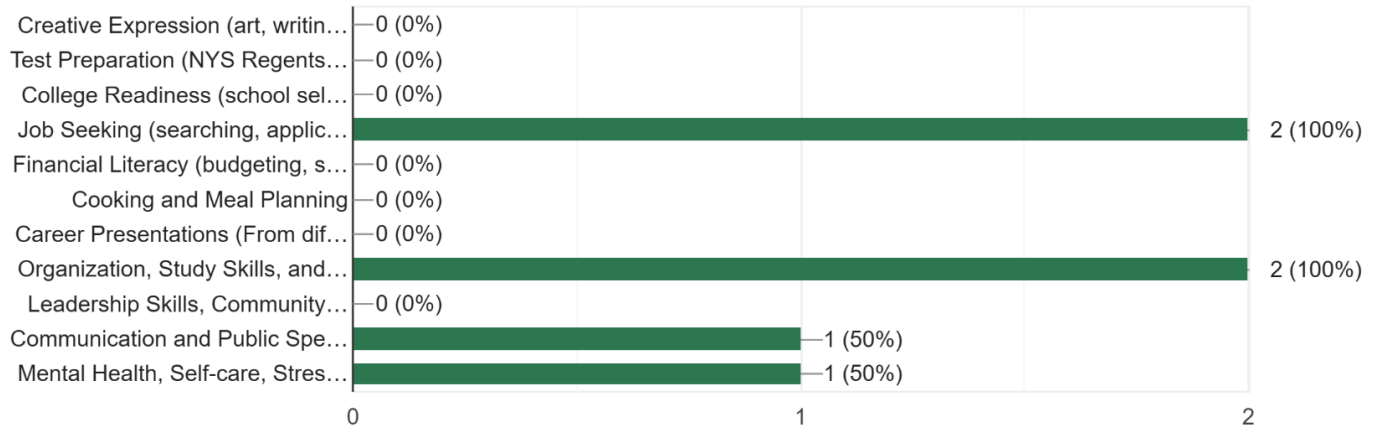

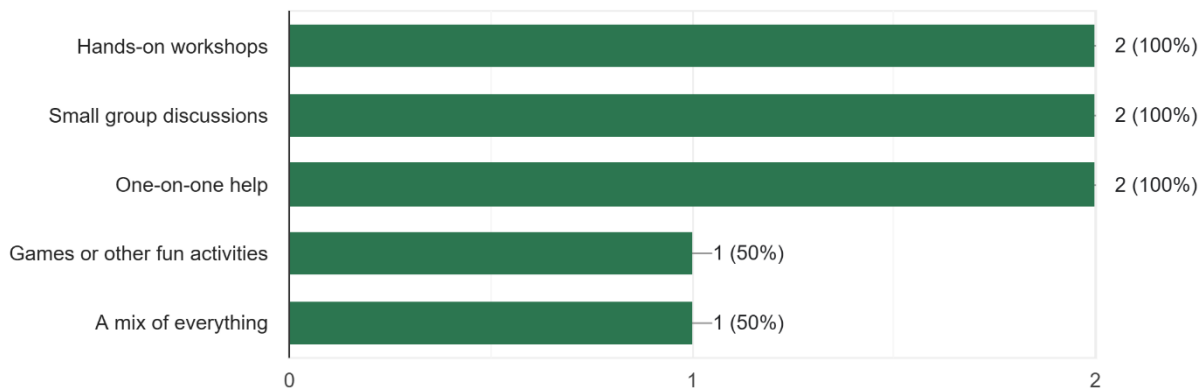
8. Which programs from guest speakers would you most like to see? (Pick up to three)

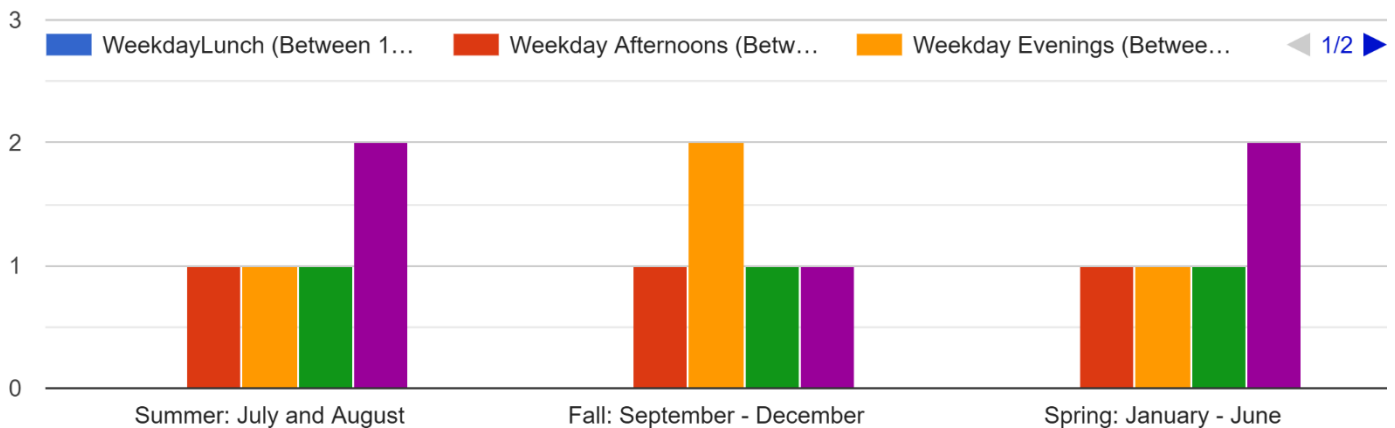


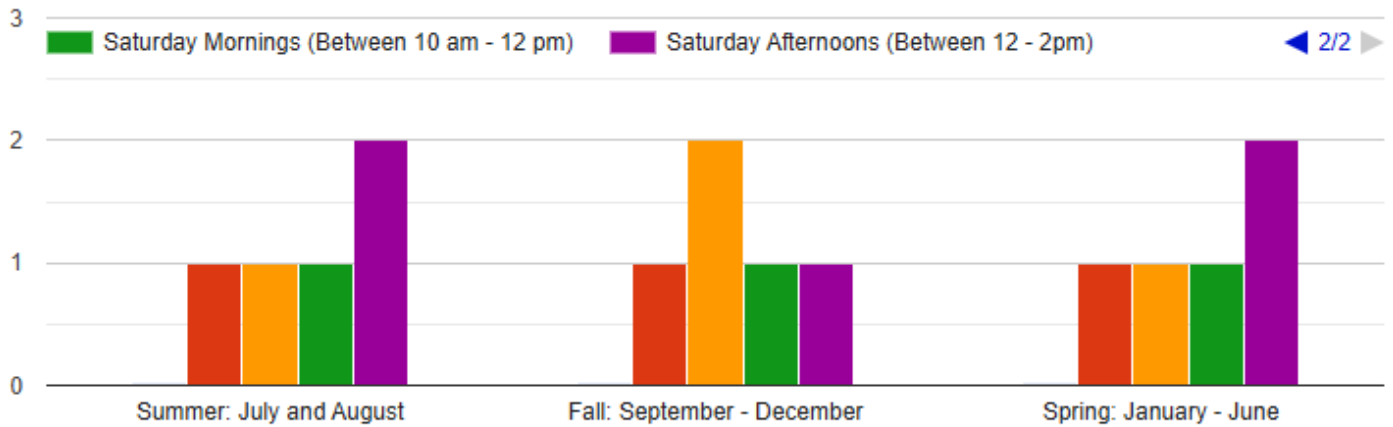
9. What types of activities do you like to do? (Select all that apply)

10. When can you to come to programs at the library?

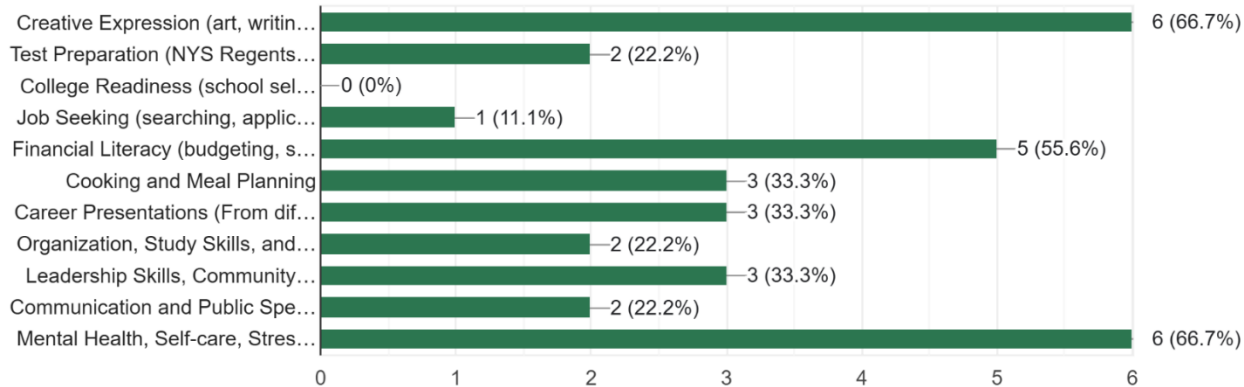

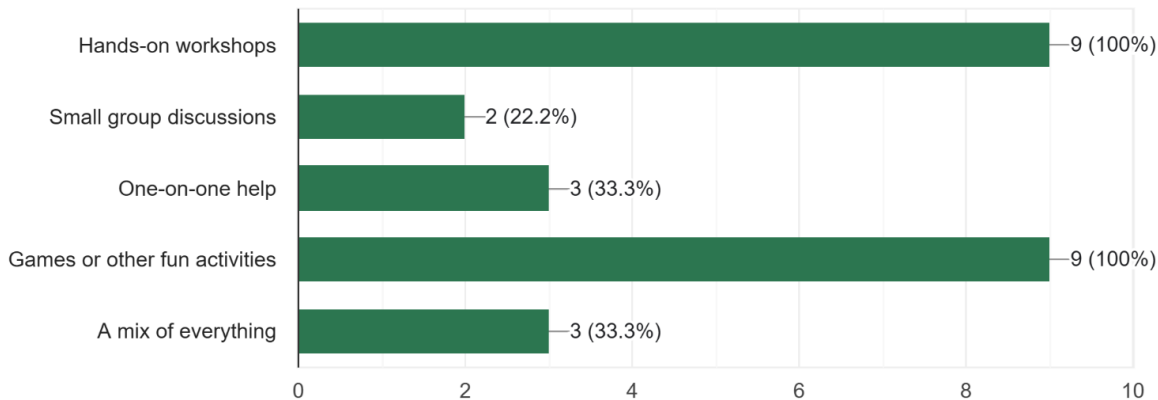
11. Which youth programs from guest speakers would you most like to see? (Pick up to three)

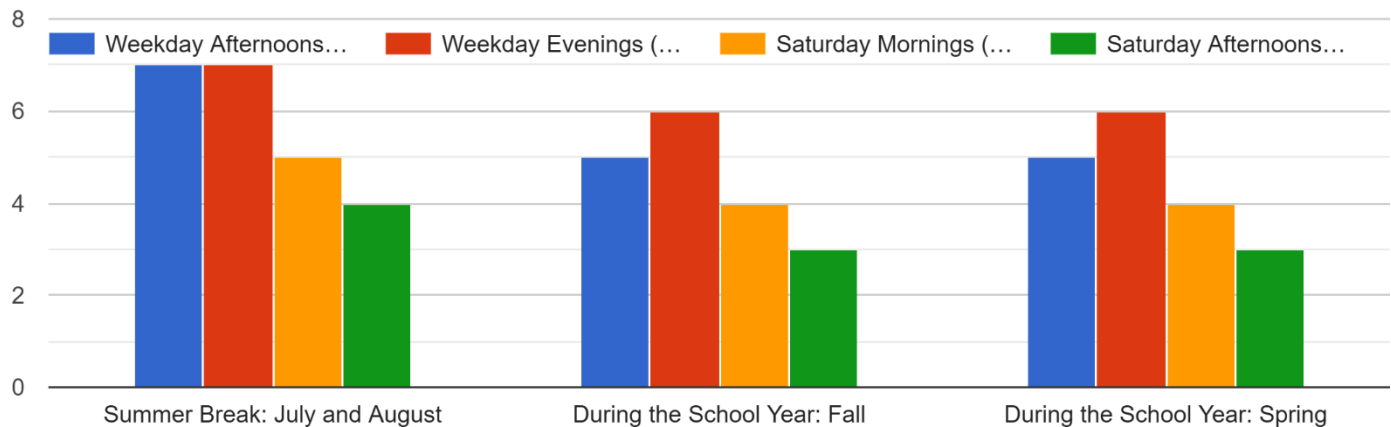


12. What types of activities does your young person like to do? (Select all that apply)

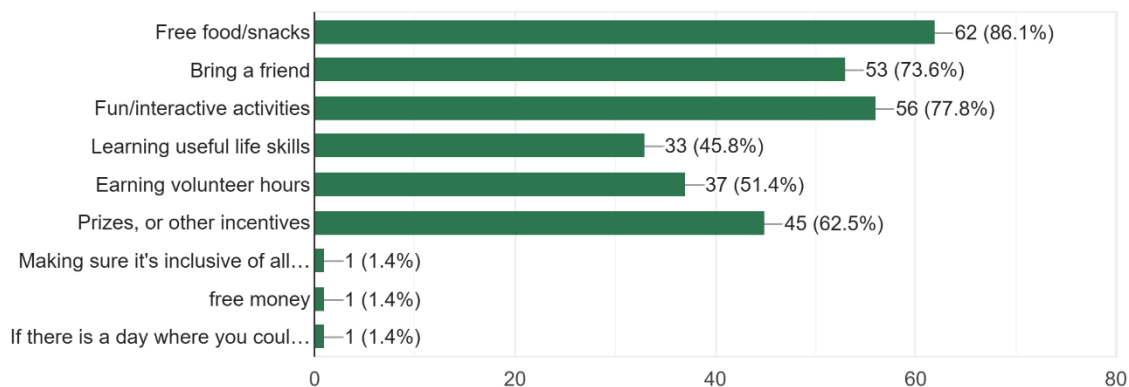
13. When can your young person come to programs at the library?

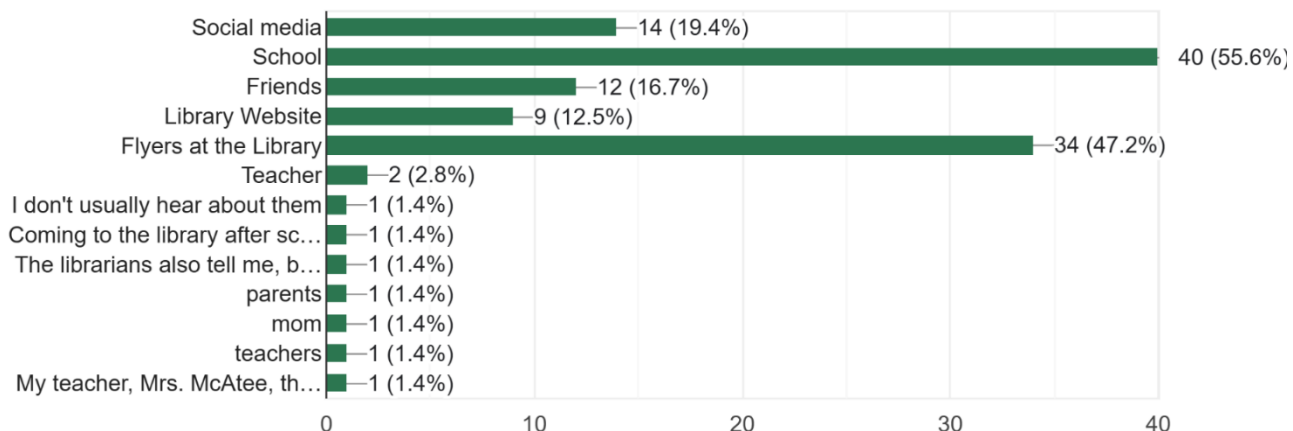
14. What would make you or your person more likely to attend a program? (Select all that apply)

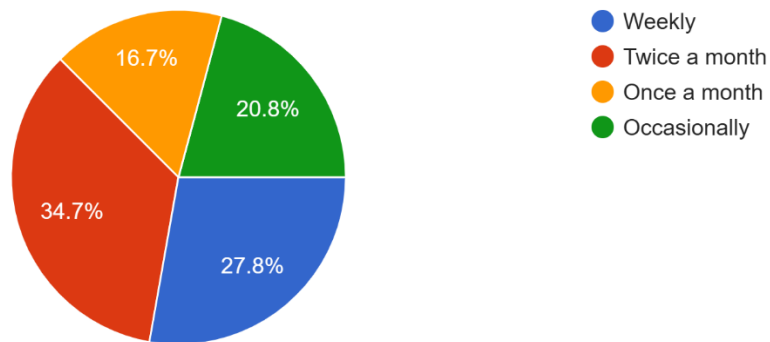
15. How do you usually hear about library programs? (Select all that apply)

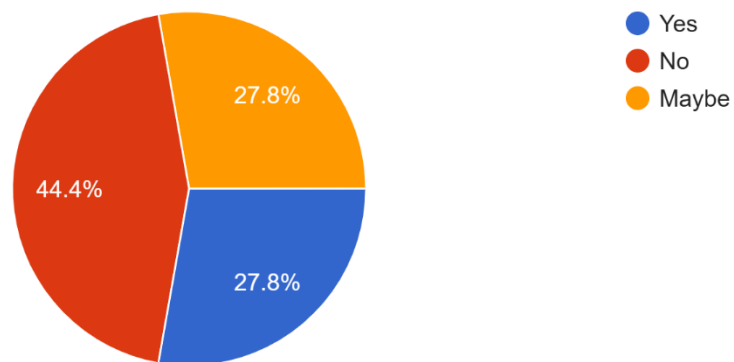
16. How often would you like us to offer programs at the library for tweens, teens, and/or young adults?
