## “Sold on a Monday” by Kristina McMorris

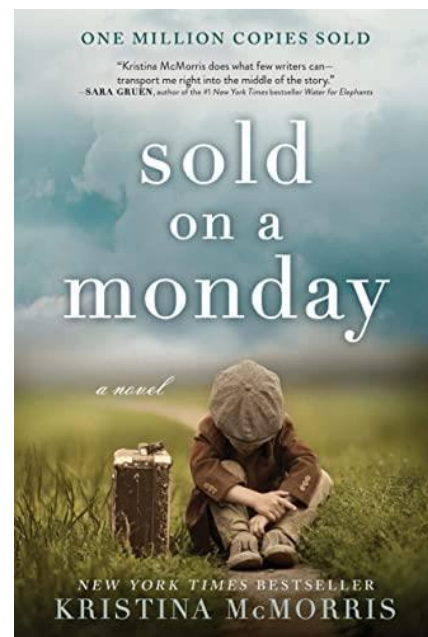
