In May 1944, RCMP Mountie Miles Lundin is assigned temporarily to England to be indoctrinated into the most important secret of the war - the ULTRA intercepts. Instead, he is called on to solve a murder of a Canadian soldier just before the amphibious invasion of France - code named NEPTUNE.

As he works through the list of possible motives and suspects, he uncovers tensions between Canadian forces and British Commandos that trace back to the calamitous raid at Dleppe in 1942. He also has to manage a conflict between the Canadian force leadership and his friend and colleague in the British Admiralty, Commander Ian Fleming.

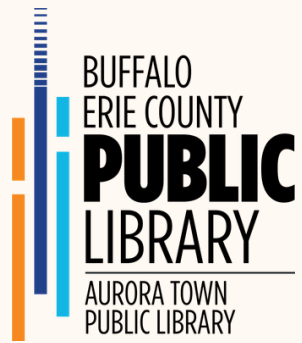

He has had several different jobs over the years including archeologist, paratrooper, intelligence officer and instructor for several special operations units. Seeger led multiple, small unit teams during his service including leading one of the CIA teams that infiltrated into Afghanistan after 9/11. Seeger's CIA awards include the Intelligence Star, the Distinguished Career Intelligence Medal, and the George H.W. Bush Award for Counterterrorism Excellence.

Seeger is a published author with 15 novels, two short stories and over thirty articles in the Intelligence Community peer reviewed journal Studies in Intelligence. He has two articles in the Journal of the T.E. Lawrence Society. He has published three articles for the blog Watches of Espionage and two in the online blog for the company SpyScape.

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
