Libraries are constantly evolving to meet the needs of their communities. Today's patrons might be looking for help with their E-reader or other technology as well as picking up books for everyone in their family and a few movies to watch. But one thing remains the same-- they know that they can find what they need at the library at no cost!

University Express programs, storytimes and other programs remain popular with a variety of audiences. The monthly "Cookbook Club" has a core of dedicated members who come together to share dishes from a chosen cookbook and the "Morning Book Club" unites readers who share their views on the selected title each month.

Two big projects happened in 2024 as we replaced both the carpeting and the landscaping.

In March new carpeting was installed throughout the building thanks to funding from the Central Library's Facilities and Improvement Initiative. It was a big undertaking when you think of all the things that had to be moved! Thanks to good logistical planning and hard work on the part of our staff, board members, some community volunteers and the carpet installers, the Library only had to offer limited services for one and a half days.

A drainage issue prompted the Town to remove all the existing landscaping and install new drain tiles and do other remedial outdoor work. Thanks to a grant from The Eden Community Foundation new foundation plantings went in during the summer and our board of trustees faithfully watered the new shrubs and perennials until fall.

April's total solar eclipse and the availability of protective eyewear through the Buffalo and Erie County Public Library System meant that our staff was busy handing out glasses right up to the day before the eclipse.

Our staff continues to rise to the occasion and meets every challenge with grace, ingenuity, and a desire to provide the best possible service for library patrons here in Eden. Our hope is that the Eden Library will always be "a special place" for residents and visitors alike.
