The Eden Library is a public library under the jurisdiction of the New York State Education Department. It enters into contract with the Buffalo and Erie County Library system each year which provides the budgeted funds.

The library building and grounds are owned and maintained by the Town of Eden. The Eden Town Board appoints the board members (trustees) at the recommendation of the Eden Library trustees.

At our annual meeting in January, the library officers for 2022 were elected and are listed above. The library board approved both the library director's and the president's reports.

Circulation has been stable as well as patron visits and Wi-Fi use. Programs offered at the Library continue to be well attended with a variety of offerings for all age groups. The "Friends of the Eden Library" continued their support this year. The Friends group sponsored a Chicken Barbecue, an

Ice Cream Social and various programs throughout the year. Community use includes Eden Recreation, Alzheimers Association, author talks, Eden Central School district and the University Express Programs. The University express offered programs including estate planning, stretching dollars at the grocery store as well as an informative discussion of Dr. Roswell Park and women in the Civil War. The Appalachian Dulcimer group provided holiday music at Christmas.

Our fall book sale and the ongoing book sale continue to be very successful. John Mills made a generous donation to the library. Donations were also received from Home Depot, the Eden Teacher's association and the Eden Foundation.

2022 was another year of change at the Eden Library. We welcomed our new Buffalo and Erie County Library Director John Spears. Pat Nagel retired and we welcomed William Ruof to our library staff.

Library trustees, Mr Sacilowski and community volunteers provided maintenance and planted flowers, trees and shrubs. Thank you to the Agles Farm and Market for the beautiful geraniums and summer arrangements.

Our library continues to be an asset to the Eden community. Eden Library serves our population by offering story hours and children's programming including April WOW, Pumpkin Patch and the Nickel City Reptile program which were very well attended. Donna-Jo participated in a mental health night at the Eden Elementary school and provided book marks and applications for library cards.

The yarn club remains very active. The yarn club has donated over 6000 items to local charities throughout the region.

DVD rentals, audio books, electronic books, music, internet access, "mono mouse" readers for the visually impaired, and computer classes are some of the many offerings to our community.

Thank you to Donna-Jo Webster, our Library Director, for making reading fun and enjoyable. She continues to have a positive impact by offering programs to stimulate learning as well as encouraging community and school involvement.
