Call to Order: 6:00PM by Mary Cooke. Our guests were welcomed.

**Approval of Minutes:** Minutes from the 2023 annual meeting were accepted with one correction. Under Reports #h, the volunteer of the year was selected for 2023 (not 2003). A motion was made by Debbie Beis and seconded by Jan Yardley to approve the corrected minutes. All were in approval.

#### Reports:

All were in approval. A request was also made to appove\$150 for the Ice Cream Social scheduled for Monday, July 8<sup>th</sup>. A motion was made by Jill and seconded by Nancy to approve the funds. All were in approval.
- d. Trustee's Report: Jill Banaszak added to the report given by Bridgette that a \$500 Earth Day grant from Air and Waste Management Associates has funded the Little Library. Gardening books are being donated and the Little Library is being stocked by the Friends.
- e. **Election of Officers:** A slate of officers, including Jill Banaszak for Vice-President, Joyce Thornton for Corresponding Secretary, Nancy Vizzi for Treasurer and Board Members with 2 year terms: Phyllis Gallie, Richard Smythe and Jan Yardley, was presented.
