Call to Order: 6:00 PM by Mary Cooke.

Approval of Minutes: Phyllis made a motion to accept the minutes from the November 10, 2022 meeting, seconded by Jan. All were in approval.

Correspondence: None to report.

Reports:

Treasurer: Nancy reported our checking account balance is \$2,312, We have \$10,256 in savings. Expenses for Nov/Dec were \$1,346 for tables for book sales and programs, and \$317 for Italian cooking class costs and fees. The Treasurer's report has been received, reviewed, and filed for audit.

- **a. Membership:** Our membership list is current, and Phyllis will use it to plan for the next book sale. Thanks to Jan for all the effort involved in updating the list.
- b. Book Sorting and Book Sale Room: Donations are being accepted and either boxed or shelved. The storeroom shelves will be again available for use when the children's area reconfiguration is complete. Russ suggested changes to the book sorting categories. These will be implemented after the April book sale. Marie will assist Russ with the changes.
- c. Director's Report: Bridgette reported.
 - The new hours for 2023 were discussed.
 - We netted \$444 at the 2022 Discard Book Sale. Purchases from last year's Wish List notebook will be made starting next month.
 - Goals for this year include funding the Terry Klaaren mural in the Children's Area, concrete work around the North (parking lot) entrance, and bollards to help protect our new doors. Any extra funds will be used for improvements to our phone system.
 - A handout was distributed listing ongoing and outreach activities and programs scheduled for next year.
 - The first meeting of the Reading Garden committee was held on 11/28/22 to discuss first steps and possible layout. Included in the discussion was a possible Little Free Library incorporated that is stocked by the Friends and a possible second Little Free Library at the WNY Welcome Center. Nancy will follow up with the Welcome Center and report back at our March meeting. Russ suggested using this as a project for the Eagle Scouts and will follow up.

 - Jill reported the Trustees continue working on the library 5-year plan. Their next meeting will be on February 9th.

- **e. The Annual Meeting** will be held on May 4th, 23rd or 25th based on speaker availability. Richard is going to follow up with Mary Kate O'Connell for possible programming.
- f. The next donated book sale will be April 13 (set-up), Friends' sale Friday, April 14 and open sale Saturday, April 15th. Russ will chair Thursday and Friday and Phyllis will chair Saturday.
