

## Resolution to Provide Upfront Funding for the Proposed Music Garden

At a duly scheduled meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Hamburg Public Library, held in-person and remotely via Zoom at 6:00 p.m. on the 12th day of September 2022, the following preamble and resolution was offered by <sup>Director Brian Hoth</sup>, motion made by Cate Lee, and seconded by Dr. Holly Schreiber. Motion was approved by the Board of Trustees by the vote indicated below; to wit:

### BACKGROUND:

An outdoor art project was proposed by Assemblymember Jonathon Rivera for the park adjacent to the Lake Shore Public Library with funding through Art Services, Inc. Director Brian Hoth suggested Mr. Rivera's office fund a Music Garden with outdoor musical instruments purchased from Percussion Play, Limited. Director Hoth feels it would become a unique attraction and destination since no other libraries in Erie County have one.

### WHEREAS:

Assemblymember Rivera's office has agreed that this is an appropriate and worthwhile project suitable for funding.

### WHEREAS:

The deadline for spending the funding is March 31, 2023.

### RESOLUTION:

Assemblymember Rivera's office is asking that the Hamburg Public Library pay for the total cost upfront until the funding is received from Art Services, Inc. for reimbursement.
