

Open Meetings Policy

This policy is applicable to the Hamburg and Lake Shore libraries.

In accordance with New York State's Open Meetings Law, members of the public are welcome to attend the Hamburg Public Library Board of Trustees meetings. Library Board meetings are for the conduct of library business. New York State's Open Meetings Law confers upon the public the right to observe the performance of public officials and to attend and listen to the deliberations and decisions that go into the making of public policy. In addition, each regular meeting of the Hamburg Public Library Board of Trustees includes an agenda item for "Public Comment" during which comments from the public can be made.
