- *ITEM #02:* Policies: Director, Glenn Luba will have two policies ready for the trustees to review and to vote on at the next board meeting.
- *ITEM #03:* Director III: This title would be applicable to the Hamburg, Tonawanda, and Cheektowaga libraries which have two library locations within their boundaries instead of one. The Central administrative team is still working out financial details with the respective towns to achieve this agreed upon goal.

NEW BUSINESS

- *ITEM #04:* ACT Meeting Update: Saturday, September 24, 2022 ACT meeting has been officially cancelled. Richard Earn the ACT president has passed away. No further details are known at this time regarding a rescheduled meeting.
- *ITEM #05:* Surplus Movement: Ten chairs from surplus storage at Anna Reinstein have found a new home at the Lackawanna Library. Ten oak cubicle cabinets are being offered for auction via the County website and the Central Library will help move a backlog of miscellaneous items by end of this December.
- *ITEM #06:* Possible Replacement Lights: Director, Glenn Luba is looking into replacing the main pendent lights at the Julia Boyer Reinstein Library with LED based lights. A possible replacement light has been ordered as a sample to be tested for brightness.

• *ITEM #07:* Many new staff: We recently had six positions vacant simultaneously between both libraries. Five of them have been filled and are in the process of being trained. Nicole Brown, the new Librarian II, having managerial duties at both branches, introduced herself to the Trustees and updated them on programs and other activities.
